PRODUCTION OF EGGS

March, 1956

The estimated production of eggs in Canada 1/ during March was 35.9 million dozen as compared with the February estimate of 34.1 million dozen and the 37.1 million dozen during March last year. The estimate of egg production during the first three months of 1956 was 107.2 million dozen compared with 109.2 million dozen for the same period in 1955.

Average egg production per layer during March was 16.3 eggs compared with 14.9 eggs last month. The rate of lay for March, 1955 was 16.1.

Froducers sold 29.3 million dozen eggs for market during March compared with the February estimate of 28.0 million dozen. Estimated consumption of eggs by producers during March was 4.6 million dozen.

FROZEN EGGS: Processing to frozen egg during March, 1956 in all plants under inspection reporting to the Department of Agriculture and in uninspected plants reporting to the Dominion Bureau of Statistics was 875,345 pounds.
