

PRODUCTION OF EGGS

August, 1956

The estimated production of eggs in Canada 1/during August was 28.7 million dozen, as compared with 28.6 million dozen last month and the 25.2 million dozen for August last year. The estimate of egg production during the first eight months of 1956 was 265.0 million dozen compared with 256.3 million dozen for the same period in 1955.

Average egg production per layer during August was 13.4 eggs compared with 14.6 eggs last month. The rate of lay for August, 1955 was 12.2.

Producers sold 23.9 million dozen eggs for market during August compared with the July estimate of 23.7 million dozen. Estimated consumption of eggs by producers during August was 4.3 million dozen.

FROZEN EGGS: Processing to frozen egg during August, 1956 in all plants under inspection reporting to the Department of Agriculture and in uninspected plants reporting to the Dominion Bureau of Statistics was 1,734,614 pounds.
