

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PRODUCTION OF POULTRY AND EGGS

1960

Total estimated value of poultry and egg production in 1960 was \$300.6 million. Farm cash income from sale of poultry and eggs totalled \$271.9 million while the value of poultry and eggs consumed by producers amounted to \$28.6 million.

Poultry meat production in 1960 at 472.9 million pounds, eviscerated weight, was 5.9 per cent less than the record 502.8 million pounds produced in 1959. Production of fowl and chicken meat declined by 2.0 per cent to 357.9 million pounds from 365.2 million. Output of turkey meat fell considerably by 17.6 per cent to 107.6 million pounds from 130.6 million, goose meat to 3.1 million from 3.2 million while duck rose to 4.1 million from 3.8 million in 1959. Of the total poultry meat production in 1960 fowl and chicken accounted for 75.7 per cent; turkey, 22.8; goose, 0.6 per cent and duck, 0.9 per cent. The total farm value of poultry meat production in 1960 amounted to \$146.4 million, down 1.3 per cent from 1959. Thus the decrease in value was less than the decrease in weight reflecting somewhat higher unit values in 1960.

Less fowl and chicken meat was produced in 1960 than in 1959 in Prince Edward Island, New Brunswick, Ontario, Manitoba and Saskatchewan while more was produced in the other provinces. The three Maritime provinces accounted for 5.1 per cent of the fowl and chicken meat produced in Canada in 1960, Quebec, 25.5 per cent; Ontario, 40.0 per cent; the Prairies, 21.1 per cent and British Columbia, 8.3 per cent.

Turkey meat production in 1960 was close to the 1958 level but much less than the record production in 1959. The three Maritime provinces produced 1.4 per cent of the turkey meat, Quebec, 12.3 per cent; Ontario, 37.3 per cent; the Prairies, 41.2 per cent and British Columbia, 7.8 per cent.

There was a net into-storage movement of .9 million pounds of poultry meat in 1960 while in 1959 there was a net out-of-storage movement of 19.4 million pounds. Exports of poultry meat were relatively

small both years. Imports increased to 22.8 million pounds from 8.2 million in 1959. Estimated per capita consumption of poultry meat in 1960 was 27.8 pounds (30.4 in 1959); fowl and chicken, 20.9 (22.0); turkey, 6.4 (7.9); goose, 0.2 (0.2); duck, 0.3 (0.3).

Egg production in 1960 at 451.0 million dozen, was 1.9 per cent less than the record production of 460.0 million in 1959. Although there were 4.4 per cent fewer layers than in 1959 the rate of lay per hundred layers increased to 19,516 from 19,026. For each of the first six months of the year less eggs were produced than in the corresponding months of 1959, while the opposite was true for the last six months of the year.

The three Maritime provinces produced 7.9 per cent of all eggs in 1960, Quebec, 13.0 per cent; Ontario, 43.0 per cent; the Prairies, 27.6 per cent and British Columbia, 8.5 per cent.

Out of a net production of 451.0 million dozen in 1960 an estimated 383.1 million dozen valued at \$128.8 million were sold for consumption. In 1959 the net production was 460.0 million dozen of which 393.1 million dozen valued at \$130.8 million were sold for consumption.

Although 9.0 million dozen less eggs were produced in 1960 than in 1959 it is estimated that 7.9 million dozen more were consumed in 1960. The main factor in this situation was that 19.0 million dozen fewer eggs were exported in 1960, than in 1959. The increase in consumption was in line with the somewhat higher population in 1960 so that per capita consumption in 1960 at 24.0 dozen was the same as in 1959.

Note: Surveys on which to base estimates of poultry and egg production have not been extended to Newfoundland; hence production in that province, while increasing but still of relatively minor significance in Canada totals, is not included in this report.
