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

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## PRODUCTION OF POULTRY AND EGGS

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This report covers poultry meat and egg statistics for the period 1941 to 1962 with estimates for 1956-61 being revised to conform with census data.

Estimates of poultry meat production and consumption, with data on stocks and external trade, have been calculated on an eviscerated weight basis from 1955 to date. The change in procedure from reporting poultry meat estimated on dressed weight basis was adopted because most poultry meat now reaches the consumer in eviscerated form and because, expressed in this way, comparisons of poultry meat production and consumption with that of other meats are more valid. To facilitate historical comparisons of poultry meat consumption the dressed weight per capita consumption estimates for the years 1941 to 1954 have been converted to approximately equivalent eviscerated weight by reducing them to the following percentages: fowl and chicken, 77 per cent; turkey, 85 per cent; goose, 80 per cent; duck, 77 per cent.

**Poultry meat production** in 1962 amounted to 566.0 million pounds only 0.2 percent less than the record 567.2 million pounds produced in 1961. Production of fowl and chicken meat declined by 1.2 per cent to 411.5 million pounds from 416.4 million in 1961. Output of turkey meat rose to a new high of 147.2 million pounds from 143.8 million in 1961 an increase of 2.3 per cent. Goose meat production at 2.9 million pounds was approximately the same as in 1961 while the output of duck meat rose to 4.4 million pounds from 4.0 million.

The total farm value of poultry meat production in 1962 amounted to \$163.0 million, up 6.6 per cent from 1961. Thus while there was an increase in value there was a slight decrease in production, reflecting higher unit values in 1962.

Per capita consumption of poultry meat in 1962, with 1961 figures in brackets, was as follows: total poultry meat, 31.0 pounds (31.1); fowl and chicken, 22.9 pounds (23.0); turkey, 7.7 pounds (7.6); goose, 0.1 pounds (0.2); duck, 0.3 pounds (0.3).

**Egg production** increased by 1.0 per cent to 434.2 million dozen in 1962 from a revised estimate of 429.9 million dozen in 1961. Average number of layers at 26.4 million was about the same as in 1961, while the rate of lay advanced to 199 from 197 eggs per layer. In 1941 the average rate of lay was 141 eggs per layer.

While total domestic consumption of eggs was slightly higher in 1962 than in 1961 this increase was not sufficient to compensate for the growth in population and average per capita consumption amounted to 22.5 dozen as compared with 22.6 dozen in 1961.

**Note:** Surveys on which estimates of poultry and egg production are based have not been extended to Newfoundland; hence production in that province, while increasing, but still of relatively minor significance in Canada totals, is not included in this report.
