

PRODUCTION OF POULTRY AND EGGS 1963

The estimated value of poultry and egg production in 1963 was \$339.5 million. Farm cash income from the sale of poultry and eggs totalled \$317.2 million while the value of poultry and eggs used by producers amounted to \$22.3 million.

Poultry meat production reached a new peak of 607.0 million pounds in 1963, this was 7.2 per cent more than the 566.0 million pounds produced in 1962, and 7.0 per cent higher than the previous record of 567.2 million pounds in 1961. Production of fowl and chicken meat increased by 10.2 per cent to 453.4 million pounds from 411.5 million in 1962, while the output of turkey meat declined to 146.3 million pounds, from 147.2 million in 1962. Of the total meat production in 1963 fowl and chicken accounted for 74.6 per cent; turkey, 24.2; goose, 0.5 per cent and duck, 0.7 per cent. The total farm value of poultry meat production in 1963 amounted to \$179.1 million, up 9.9 per cent from 1962. The increase in value was more than the increase in weight, reflecting higher unit values in 1963.

All provinces except Prince Edward Island produced more fowl and chicken meat than in 1962. The three Maritime provinces accounted for 4.6 per cent of the fowl and chicken meat produced in Canada in 1963, Quebec, 31.8 per cent; Ontario, 35.1 per cent; the Prairies, 20.2 per cent and British Columbia, 8.3 per cent. Separate estimates are provided for fowl and chicken meat production in 1963.

There was a net out-of-storage movement of 1.9 million pounds of poultry meat in 1963 compared to 3.5 million pounds in 1962. Exports of poultry meat were relatively small both years. Imports decreased to 7.7 million pounds from 8.6 million in 1962. Estimated per capita consumption

of poultry meat in 1963 was 32.6 pounds, (31.0 in 1962); fowl and chicken, 23.8 pounds, (22.9); turkey, 8.3 (7.7); goose, 0.15 (0.14); duck, 0.30 (0.31).

Egg production in 1963 at 417.9 million dozen was 3.7 per cent less than the estimate of 434.2 million dozen produced in 1962 and 6.8 per cent less than the record production of 448.2 million dozen in 1959. There were 3.9 per cent fewer layers than in 1962 while the rate of lay per 100 layers increased to 19,943 from 19,921. The average farm selling price of eggs increased to 37.5 cents per dozen from 34.3 cents in 1962. Despite the lower production this resulted in an increase in total value of eggs produced.

The three Maritime provinces produced 7.8 per cent of all eggs in 1963, Quebec 15.8 per cent; Ontario, 40.7 per cent; the Prairies, 24.8 per cent and British Columbia, 10.9 per cent.

Out of a net production of 417.9 million dozen in 1963 an estimated 367.0 million dozen valued at \$137.7 million were sold for consumption. In 1962 the net production was 434.2 million dozen of which 383.6 million dozen valued at \$131.8 million were sold for consumption.

Exports of eggs were relatively small both years. Due to a decrease in production, imports increased to 8.8 million dozen from 3.7 million dozen in 1962. Per capita consumption fell to 21.5 dozen from 22.5 dozen a year earlier. Per capita consumption has declined each year since reaching a peak of 25.0 dozen in 1957.

Note: Surveys on which to base estimates of poultry and egg production have not been extended to Newfoundland; hence production in that province, while increasing but still of relatively minor significance in Canada totals, is not included in this report.
