

## FUR PRODUCTION

For the 1971-72 fur season the value of pelts was \$33,009,928 an increase of 20% from the 1970-71 level. The value of wildlife pelts sold during the season 1971-72 amounted to \$18,320,997 or 55.5% of the total value. The value of fur farm pelt production increased to \$14,688,931 from \$14,507,455. The value of ranch mink pelts sold was well below the peak of \$28,279,404 in 1965.

Data on wildlife pelt production included in this report are supplied by the various provincial and territorial governments which compile statistics for their respective areas on the basis of royalty payments, export taxes, etc. Where such facilities for collection of statistics locally do not exist, data on purchase of pelts are solicited from fur dealers etc.

Data on fur farm pelt production included in this report relate to the previous calendar year rather than the wildlife fur year ending June 30 and are covered in greater detail in the "Report on Fur Farms", Catalogue 23-208. This information except for prices, is obtained from an annual census of the fur farm industry. Mink and fox farms are licensed in all provinces except Prince Edward Island and New Brunswick and provincial departments provide mailing lists based on licenses issued.

Statistics Canada coverage of the chinchilla industry was discontinued at the end of 1969. Complete lists were not obtainable because many kept only a few animals in basements, garages, etc., and there was a large turnover of ranchers each year. In 1969, 18,664 pelts were produced valued at \$170,761.

Ranch mink pelt data are obtained from Canada Mink Breeders Association, for Canada as a whole, therefore, they do not reflect differences in pelt values between provinces.

The value of undressed fur exported during the 1971-72 season increased to \$28,499,000 from \$26,247,000 in the previous season. Imports increased to \$30,020,000 compared to \$21,095,000.

## PRODUCTION DE FOURRURES

La valeur des fourrures de la saison 1971-72 s'établit à \$33,009,928, une augmentation de 20 % du niveau atteint en 1970-71. La valeur des peaux de gibier à fourrure de la saison 1971-72 s'élève à \$18,320,997, soit 55.5 % de la valeur totale. La valeur de la production des peaux d'élevage a augmenté de \$14,507,455 à \$14,688,931. La valeur des peaux de vison d'élevage s'est établie bien en-deçà du sommet de \$28,279,404 atteint en 1965.

Les données sur la production de fourrures provenant d'animaux sauvages, figurant dans le présent bulletin, proviennent des services et organismes des gouvernements provinciaux et territoriaux qui les établissent pour leurs régions respectives en fonction du paiement des redevances, des taxes à l'exportation, etc. Lorsqu'il n'existe aucun moyen de recueillir la statistique dans la région, les chiffres relatifs aux achats de fourrures sont obtenus des négociants en fourrures et autres.

Les données du bulletin sur la production de fourrures dans les fermes d'élevage sont celles de l'année civile précédente plutôt que de la saison des fourrures close le 30 juin. Ces données sont plus détaillées dans le "Rapport sur les fermes à fourrure", (Catalogue 23-208). Les renseignements, sauf dans le cas des prix, sont tirés d'un recensement annuel de l'industrie. Toutes les provinces, sauf l'Île-du-Prince-Édouard et le Nouveau-Brunswick, accordent des permis aux exploitants de fermes de vison et de renard, et les ministères fournissent des listes d'adresses fondées sur le nombre de permis délivrés.

À la fin de 1969, Statistique Canada cessait de publier des données sur l'industrie du chinchilla. Il était impossible de dresser des listes complètes vu qu'un grand nombre d'éleveurs se contentaient d'élever quelques animaux seulement dans leur sous-sol, leur garage, etc., et chaque année on assistait à un roulement considérable d'éleveurs. En 1969 il a été produit 18,664 peaux évaluées à \$170,761.

Les données sur les peaux des fermes de visons sont obtenues de l'Association canadienne des éleveurs de visons pour l'ensemble du Canada, et ne peuvent donc pas indiquer les écarts de valeur des fourrures entre les provinces.

La valeur des peaux brutes exportées au cours de la saison 1971-72 a augmenté à \$28,499,000 de \$26,247,000 qu'elle était la saison précédente. Les importations sont passées à \$30,020,000 en regard de \$21,095,000.
