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## STORAGE HOLDINAS OF FISH, APRIL 1, 1939.

## ALI FISH.

Stocks of all figh, 97, April 1, 1939 aggregated million 1 b ., (including
19.4 an estimate of for firms who failed to report on time), of which million 1b. were Frozon Fresh; 1.3 million lb. Frozen Smoked, and 2.1 million 1b. Cured. These figures are grenter by million lb. Fresh and Frozen, and less by 98 thousand $2 b$. Smoked, Dried, Fickled and Silted than those of April $1, .1938$. As compared with March 1, 19.39 figures they are per cent qeis for Frozen Fresh, 18.5 per cent less for Frozen Smoked and 14.7 per cent greater for Cured.

C O D The stocks of all Cod totalled $3,180,518 \mathrm{lb}$. of which $1,521,647 \mathrm{lb}$. were Frozen Fresh; 607,305 1b. Frozen Smoked, and 1,051,566 lb. Cured. These figures are equivalent to 99.9 per cent of last month's stocks and are $136,567 \mathrm{lb}$. more than the stonks on April 1, 1938.

There was an apparent net "Out-of-Storage" movement of 4 thousand 1b. as compared with 745 thousand 1 b . for a similar movement last year.

The quantity frozen during March 1939 was $988,803 \mathrm{lb}$. as compared with the total of $760,000 \mathrm{lb}$. for March 1938 .

HADDUCK. Gll Haddock stocks including Finnan Haddies, were 1, 471,320 1b. consisting of 764,362 1b. Frozer Fresh; 674,254 1b. Frozen Smoked and 32,704 1b. Cured. These are less by 17.3 per cent than the stocks of March 1, 1939 and 337,980 1b. less than at the same time last year.

The apparent net "Out-of-Storace" movement was 307 thousand 1 b . Last year the "Out-of-Storage" movenent was 299 thousand 1b.

The catch frozen durine March 1939, 542,620 1b., Was 252 thousand 1b. greater than the quantity frozen during March 1938.

FAKE, CUSK The stocks totalled $63,539 \mathrm{1b}$. These stocks are 35.8 per cent less than \& POLLOCK. the revised figures for wirch 1, 1939.

SAIMON. Holdings of all Salmon were 3,222,358 1b. made up of 2,754,572 1b. Frozen Fresh; 10,176 1b Frozen Smoked, and 457,610 1b. Cured. These holdings are 550 thousand 1 b . greater then at April 1, 1938 and 38.5 per cent less than those of March 1, 1939.

The apparent net "Out-of-Storage" movement during March was 2.0 million 1b as compared with a similar movement of 1.6 million lb. during March 1938.

Salmon frozen durine March 1939 totalled 96,800 lb . as compared with 58,950 lb. last year.

SEA HMRRING. The total stocks of this classification, including Kippers and Bloaters, were $4,187,166 \mathrm{lb}$. as compared with $2,868,891 \mathrm{lb}$. last year and are 80.4 per cent of last month':s revised fifures.

Quantities of See Herring, Fresh and Smoked, frozen during March 1939 were reported as 1,860 lb . as compared with freezings of 733,649 1b. during March 1938.
