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STORAGE HOLDINGS OF FISH, MAY 1, 1939.

ALL FISH.

Stocks of all fish on May 1, 1939 aggregated 20.3 million 1b. of which 16.2 million 1b. were Frozen Fresh; 2.1 million 1b. Frozen Smoked, and 2.0 million 1b. Cured. These figures are greater by 3.3 million 1b. Fresh and Frozen, and less by 372 thousand 1b. Smoked, Dried, Pickled and Salted than those of May 1, 1938. As compared with April 1, 1939 figures they are 16.4 per cent less for Frozen Fresh, 21.6 per cent greater for Frozen Smoked and 4.4 per cent less for Cured.

COD

The stocks of all Cod totalled 3,842,889 lb. of which 1,705,806 lb.

were Frozen Fresh; 1,023,934 lb. Frozen Smoked, and 1,113,149 lb.

Cured. These figures are 20.1 per cent greater than last month's stocks and are

76,414 lb. greater than the stocks on May 1, 1938,

There was an apparent net "Into-Storage" movement of 644 thousand lb. as compared with 723 thousand lb. for a similar movement last year.

with the total of 554,267 lb. for April 1938.

HADDOCK.

All Haddock stock including Finnan Haddies, were 1,666,328 lb. consisting of 959,634 lb. Frozen Fresh; 662,466 lb. Frozen Smoked and 44,228 lb. Cured. These are greater by 11.7 per cent than the stocks of April 1, 1939 and 370,899 lb. less than at the same time last year.

The apparent net "Into-Storage" movement was 175 thousand lb. Last year the "Into-Storage" movement was 228 thousand lb.

The catch frozen during April 1939, 747,587 lb., was 347 thousand lb. greater than the quantity frozen during April 1938.

HAKE, CUSK

& POLLOCK

The stocks totalled 104,540 lb. These stocks are 56 thousand lb. greater than the revised figures for April 1, 1939.

SALMON.

Holdings of all Salmon were 1,799,879 lb. made up of 1,523,505 lb.

Frozen Fresh; 7,887 lb. Frozen Smoked, and 268,487 lb. Cured. These holdings are 46 thousand lb. greater than at May 1, 1938 and 44.2 per cent less than those of April 1, 1939.

The apparent net "Out-of-Storage" movement during April was 1.4 million lb. as compared with a similar movement of 919 thousand lb. during April 1938.

Salmon frozen during April 1939 totalled 5,586 lb. as compared with 3,672 lb. last year.

SEA HERRING. The total stocks of this classification, including Kippers and Bloaters, were 2,952,373 lb. as compared with 2,343,124 lb. last year and are 69.4 per cent of last month's revised figures.

Quantities of Sea Herring, Fresh and Smoked, frozen during April 1939 were reported as 1,765 lb. as compared with freezings of 1,850 lb. during April 1938.

OTHER. Other fish stocks amounted to 9,660,068 lb. Frozen Fresh; 132,305 lb. Frozen Smoked and 109,782 lb. Cured.

Quantities of Fresh and Smoked frozen during April were 1,657,721 1b.
This total includes a quantity of American-caught Halibut.
