STORAGE HOLDINGS OF FISH, JUNE 1, 1939.


#### Abstract

ALL FISH. Stocks of all fish on June 1, 1939 aggregated 21.1 million lb. (including an estimate of $434,000 \mathrm{lb}$. for firms who failed to report on timo), of which 17.4 million 1 b . were Frozen Fresh; 2.1 million lb. Frozen Smoked, and 1.6 million lb. Cured. These figures aro greater by 2.7 million $1 b$. Fresh and Frozen, and greater by 972 thousand lb. Smoked, Dried, Pickled and Salted than those of June 1, 1938. As compared with May 1, 1939 figures they are 5.7 per cent greater for Frozen Fresh, 2.2 per cent greater for Frozen Smoked and 19.8 per cent less for Cured.


The net "Into-Storage" movement for all classifications was almost 600 thousand 16 . Which is equivalent to 13.7 per cent of total reported as frozen during the month just ended. The total includes a quantity of imerican-caught Halibut.

## C O D. The stocks of all Cod totalled $3,830,061 \mathrm{lb}$. of which 1,999,987 lb .

were Frozen Fresh; 1,151,078 lb. Frozen Smoked, and 678,996 1b. Cured. These figures are 99.5 per cont of last month's stocks and are $409,259 \mathrm{lb}$. less than the stocks on June 1, 1938.

There was an apparent net "Out-of-Storage" movement of 21 thousand lb. as compared with 473 thousand 1 b . for an "Into-Storage" movement last year.

The quantity frozen during Nay 1939 was $787,793 \mathrm{lb}$. as compared with the total of $776,744 \mathrm{lb}$. for May 1938.

HADDOCK. All Haddock stock including Finnan Haddies, were 1,426,221 1b. con-
sisting of $895,224 \mathrm{lb}$. Frozen Fresh; $512,581 \mathrm{lb}$. Frozon Smoked and $18,416 \mathrm{lb}$. Cured. These are less by 14.4 per cent than the stocks of May 1, 1939 and $949,218 \mathrm{lb}$. less than at the same time last year.

The apparent net "Out-of-Storage" movement was 241 thousand 2 b . Last year the "Into-Storage" movement was 338 thousand 1 b .

The catch frozen during May 1939, 181,918 1b., was 208 thousand 1b. loss than the quantity frozen during Nay 1938.

HARE, CUSK The stocks totalled $78,827 \mathrm{lb}$. These stocks are 26 thousand lb , \& POLIOCK
less than the revised figures for May 1, 1939.
SALMON. Holdings of all Salmon were $1,158,207 \mathrm{lb}$. made up of $847,543 \mathrm{lb}$.
Frozen Fresh; 8,008 1b. Frozen Smoked, and 302,656 1b. Cured. These holdings are 30 thousand 1 b . less than at June 1, 1938 and 35.7 per cent less than those of May 1, 1939.

The apparent net "Out-of-Storage" movement during May was 644 thousand 1 b . as compared with a similar movement of 566 thousand 1b. during May 1938.

Salmon frozen during May 1939 totalled 58,518 lb. as compared with
$181,350 \mathrm{lb}$. last year.
SEA HERRING. The total stocks of this classification, including Kippers and Bloaters, were $\frac{3,023,036}{\mathrm{lb}}$. as compared with $2,920,089 \mathrm{lb}$. last year and are 2.4 per cont greater than last month's revised figures.

Quantities of Sea Herring, Fresh and Smoked including Kippers frozen during May 1939 were reported as $744,355 \mathrm{lb}$. as compared with freezings of 312,450 1b. during May 1938.

OTHER.
Other fish stocks amounted to 10,801,409 1b. Frozen Fresh; 227,052 1b. Frozen Smoked and $94,596 \mathrm{lb}$. Cured.

Quantities of Fresh and Smoked frozen during May were 2,531,539 lb . This total includes a quantity of american-caught Halibut.
