## STORAGE HOLDINGS OF FISH, JULY 1, 1939.

AIL FISH. Stocks of all fish on July 1, 1939 aggregated 26.9 million 1 b . (including an estimate of $1,203,000 \mathrm{lb}$. for firms who failod to report on time), of which 22.5 million lb, were Frozen Fresh; 2.2 million lb. Frozen Smoked, and 2.2 million 1 b . Cured. These figures are greater by 2.3 million 1 b . Frosh and Frozen and loss by 1.1 million lb. Smoked, Dried, Piokled and Salted than those of Juiy 1, 1938. As compared with June 1, 1939 figures they are 25.8 per cent greater for Frozen Fresh, 6.1 per cent greater for Frozen Smoked and 36.4 per cont greater for cured.

The net "Into-Storage" movement for all classifications was 6.3 million 1 b . which is equivalent to 74.6 per cent of total reported as frozen during the month just ended.

COD. The stocks of all Cod totalled 4,172,656 1b of which 2,122,709 lb . were Frozen Fresh; 1,161,335 1b. Frozen Smoked, and 888,612 1b. Cured. These figures are 8.6 per cent greater than last month's stocks and aro $588,528 \mathrm{lb}$. less than the stocks on July 1, 1938.

There was an apparent net "Into-Storage" movement of 332 thousand
lb, as comparod with 522 thousand 1 b . for a similar movament last year.
The quantity frozon during June 1939 was $681,640 \mathrm{lb}$. as compared with the total of $698,811 \mathrm{lb}$. for June 1938.

HADDOCK. All Haddock stock including Finnan Haddies, were 2, 328,216 lb .
These are greater by 55.8 per cent than the stocks of June 1, 1939 and $924,536 \mathrm{lb}$. less than at the same time last year.

The apparent net "Into-Storage" movement was 834 thousand 1b. Last yoar the "Into-Storage" movement was 877 thousand 1 b .

The catch frozen during June 1939, 1,503,645 1b., was 514 thousand lb. greater than the quantity frozon during June 1938.

HAKE, CUSK The stocks totalled $80,048 \mathrm{lb}$. These stocks are 1.2 thousand 1 b . \& POLIOCK
greater than the revised figures for June 1, 1939.
SAIMON. Holdings of all Salmon were 1,201,050 lb . made up of 768,385 Ib .
Frozen Fresh; 7,351 lb. Frozen Smoked, and 425,314 1b. Cured. These holdings are 826 thousand 1 b . less than at July 1, 1938 and 2.6 per cent greater than those of June 1, 1939.

The apparent net "Into-Storage" movement during June was 31
thousand 1 b . as compared with a similar movement of 838 thousand 1 b . during June 1938.
Salmon frozen during June 1939 totalled $420,930 \mathrm{lb}$. as compared with
1,036,761 1b. last year.
DEA HERRING. The total stocks of this classification, including Kippers and Bloaters, were 2,662,044 lb. as compared with 2,538,975 lb. last year and are 12 per cent less than last month's revised figures.

Quantities of Soa Herring, Fresh and Smoked, including Kippers
frozen during June 1939 were reported as 340,100 lb as compared with freezings of $\overline{155,698} \mathrm{lb}$. during June 1938.

OTHER. Other fish stooks amounted to 14,849,641 1b. Frozen Fresh; 322,517 1b. Frozen Smoked and 90,544 1b. Cured.
Quantities of Fresh and Smoked frozen during June were 4,179,576 lb .
