STORAGE HOLDINGS OF FISH, JINU:RY 1, 1940.

## ALL FISH.

Stocks of all fish on January 1,1940 aggregated 37.5 million $1 b$. of which 28.7 million 16 . were Frozon Fresh; 2.6 million lb. Frozen Smoked and 6.2 million $1 b$. Cured. These figures are less by 2.8 million lb. Frozen Fresh and 0.8 million $1 b$. Frozen Smoked, but 2.6 million lb. more for Dried, Pickled and Salted fish than at January 1, 1939. The increase in Dried, pickled and Salted is caused by firms added to the list recontly. is compred with December 1, 1939 ifgures they are 12.2 per cont less for Frozen Fresh, 0.8 por cent less for Frozen Smoked and 3.9 per cont less for Cured.

The apparent net "Out-of-Storage" movement for all classifications
was 3.9 million lb.
COD.
The reported stocks of all Cod totalled $6,636,825 \mathrm{lb}$. of which 2,686,839 lb. Were Frozen Fresh; 1,058, $3 \overline{36 \mathrm{lb} \text {. Frozen Smoked and }}$ 2,891,550 1b. Cured. The total figures are 3.6 por cont greater than last month's stocks and are 352 thousand 1 lb . Iess than the stocks on January 1, 1939.

There was an apparent net "Into-Storace" movement of 229 thousand
1b. as compared with a net "Into-Storage" movement of 123 thousand Ib. last year.
The quantity reported as frozen during December 1939, was
$1,819,826 \mathrm{lb}$. as compared with a total of $879,606 \mathrm{Ib}$. for Decomber 1938 .
HADDOCK. All Haddock stocks reportod, including Fimen Haddies, were
$1,798,343 \mathrm{lb}$. of which $1,076,191 \mathrm{lb}$. Frozen Fresin and $710,952 \mathrm{1b}$. Frozen Smoked. These holdings are less by 10.3 per cent thay tha stocks of December 1 , 1939 and 1.7 million 1 b . less than at the sime time last yoar.

The apparent net "Olit-of-Storage" movement was 207 thousand 1 lb . Last year the not "Out-of-Storage" movement was 78 thousand 1 b .

The catch reported as frozen during December 1939, 678,112 1b. was 275 thousand 1 lb . Greater than the quantity frozen during Docember $1938^{\circ}$.

HhKE, CUSK Stocks of these kinds totalled $620,1631 \mathrm{~b}$. These stocks are 62 \& POLLOCK. thousand 1b. less than the revisad figures for December 1, 1939.

## SALMON.

Reported holdings of all Salmon were 6,040,080 lb, made up of 5,199,494 1b. Frozen Fresh; 8,352 1b. Frozen Smoked, and 832,234 1b. Cured. These holdings are 2.1 million lb. less than at January 1, 2939 and 12.5 per cent loss than those of December $1,1939$.

The apparent not "Out-oi-Storage" movement during December was 860 thousand 1 b . as compared with a similar movement of 1.5 million 1 l . during December 1938.

Salmon reported as frozen during Decembor 1933 totalled 59,944 lb. as compared with $488,203 \mathrm{lb}$. last year.
SEA HERRING. The total repoited stocks of this classification, including Kippers and Bloaters, were 6,967,112 1 h . as compared with $6,538,8421 \mathrm{~b}$. per cont loss than last month's revised figures.

Quantities of Soa Herring, Fresh and Smoked, including Kippers, Irozen during December 1939 were roported as $836,919 \mathrm{Ib}$. as compared with freezings of $612,695 \mathrm{Ib}$. during Decembor 1938 .
OTHER. Other fish stocks amounted to 14,008,215 1b. Frozen Fresh, 37,489 1b. Frozell Smoked and 1,369,107 1b. Cured.

Quantities of Fresh and Smoked frozen during December were
reported as $1,109,439 \mathrm{lb}$.
