COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS OF FISH, OCTOBER 1, 1940

ALL FISH

Stocks of all frozen fish on October 1, 1940 totalled 34.5 million lb. including an estimate of 585 thousand lb. Frozen Fresh and 17 thousand lb. Frozen Smoked for firms failing to report on time. Of this total 32.4 million lb. were Frozen Fresh and 2.1 million lb. Frozen Smoked. Comparing these classifications there were 1.9 million lb. less Frozen Fresh stocks and 59 thousand lb. more stocks of Frozen Smoked than last year. Compared with last month's revised figures there was an increase on October 1, 1940 of 6.1 per cent. Frozen Fresh and a decrease of 4.5 per cent. Frozen Smoked.

The apparent net "Into-Storage" movement of frozen fish during Sept. 1940 was 1.8 million lb. as compared with an opposite movement of 778 thousand lb. for the same month last year.

C O D

Stocks of frozen Cod reported were 2,475,727 lb. of which 2,471,337 lb. were Frozen Fresh and 4,390 lb. Frozen Smoked (not including fillets), being 7.0 per cent. less than last month's frozen stocks and 406 thousand lb. more than the frozen stocks of October 1, 1939.

The apparent net "Out-of-Storage" movement of all frozen Cod (except smoked fillets) was 188 thousand lb. as compared with an opposite movement of 471 thousand lb. during September 1939, but the estimate is not included in this movement.

The quantity reported as frozen fresh during September 1940 was 1,193,243 lb. as compared with 570,603 lb. for the same month last year.

HADDOCK

Stocks of frozen Haddock, as reported, were 1,004,941 lb. of which 769,907 lb. were Frozen Fresh and 235,034 lb. Frozen Smoked (not including fillets). Haddock holdings were less by 4.3 per cent. than last month's revised stocks and 312 thousand lb. less than at the same date a year ago.

There was an apparent net "Out-of-Storage" movement of 46 thousand lb. in September (not including the estimate for firms failing to report on time) as compared with a similar movement of 1.0 million lb. during September 1939.

There were 366,066 lb. reported as frozen during Sept. being 94,068 lb. less than the quantity reported as frozen last year for the same month.

FILLETS

Frozen Smoked fillets of Cod, Haddock and other fish, as reported, amounted to 628,630 lb. as compared with 1,021,347 lb. for October 1, 1939 and 723,973 lb. last month.

The quantity reported as frozen during September 1940 was 336,967 lb.

SALMON

Frozen Salmon holdings, as reported, were 6,888,866 lb., consisting of 6,885,557 lb. Frozen Fresh and 3,309 lb. Frozen Smoked. These frozen stocks were 1.9 million lb. more than at the same date last year and 57.0 per cent. more than the stocks of a month ago.

The apparent net "Into-Storage" movement during Sept. was 2.5 million lb. as compared with a similar movement of 1.8 million lb. during the same month in 1939.

SEA HERRING

The total reported frozen stocks of Herring, including Kippers, were 9,704,422 lb. as compared with 7,159,801 lb. last year. They are 3.9 per cent. less than the revised figures for September 1, 1940.

The quantities reported as frozen during Sept. 1940 amounted to 989,402 lb. as compared with freezings of 1,935,104 lb. for Sept. 1939.

OTHER

All other frozen fish stocks amounted to 13,206,378 lb. Frozen Fresh and 19,233 lb. Frozen Smoked (not including fillets).

Quantities of other fish reported as frozen during September 1940 were 2,537,285 lb.
