COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS OF FISH, NOVEMBER 1, 1940

ALL FISH

Stocks of all frozen fish on November 1, 1940 totalled 38.4 million lb. including an estimate of 4.8 million lb. Frozen Fresh and 78 thousand lb. Frozen Smoked for firms failing to report on time. Of this total 36.2 million lb. were Frozen Fresh and 2.2 million lb. Frozen Smoked. Comparing these classifications there were 1.4 million lb. more Frozen Fresh stocks and 95 thousand lb. less stocks of Frozen Smoked than last year. Compared with last month's revised figures there was an increase on November 1, 1940 of 11.3 per cent. Frozen Fresh and an increase of 0.3 per cent. Frozen Smoked.

The apparent net "Into-Storage" movement of frozen fish during October 1940 was 3.7 million lb. as compared with a similar movement of 674 thousand lb. for the same month last year.

C O D

Stocks of frozen Cod reported were 2,153,955 lb. of which 2,145,252 lb. were Frozen Fresh and 8,703 lb. Frozen Smoked (not including fillets), being 19.3 per cent. less than last month's frozen stocks and 201 thousand lb. less than the frozen stocks of November 1, 1939.

The apparent net "Out-of-Storage" movement of all frozen Cod (except smoked fillets) was 514 thousand lb. as compared with an opposite movement of 285 thousand lb. during October 1939, but the estimate is not included in this movement.

The quantity reported as frozen fresh during October 1940 was 542,201 lb. as compared with 1,065,905 lb. for the same month last year.

HADDOCK

Stocks of frozen Haddock, as reported, were 835,075 lb. of which 647,380 lb. were Frozen Fresh and 187,695 lb. Frozen Smoked (not including fillets). Haddock holdings were less by 19.7 per cent. than last month's revised stocks and 547 thousand lb. less than at the same date a year ago.

There was an apparent net "Out-of-Storage" movement of 204 thousand lb. in October (not including the estimate for firms failing to report on time) as compared with an opposite movement of 65 thousand lb. during October 1939.

There were 235,590 lb. reported as frozen during October being 151,967 lb. less than the quantity reported as frozen last year for the same month.

FILLETS

Frozen Smoked fillets of Cod, Haddock and other fish, as reported, amounted to 775,535 lb. as compared with 1,197,237 lb. for November 1, 1939 and 639,165 lb. last month.

The quantity reported as frozen during October 1940 was 624,531 lb.

SALMON

Frozen Salmon holdings, as reported, were 7,777,706 lb., consisting of 7,770,692 lb. Frozen Fresh and 7,014 lb. Frozen Smoked. These frozen stocks were 2.0 million lb. more than at the same date last year and 12 per cent. more than the stocks of a month ago, but the estimate is not included in these calculations.

The apparent net "Into-Storage" movement during October was 833 thousand lb. as compared with a similar movement of 868 thousand lb. during the same month in 1939.

SEA HERRING

The total reported frozen stocks of Herring, including Kippers, were 9,033,630 lb. as compared with 6,756,407 lb. last year. They are 10.0 per cent. less than the revised figures for October 1, 1940.

The quantities reported as frozen during October 1940 amounted to 339,812 lb. as compared with freezings of 290,728 lb. for October 1939.

OTHER

All other frozen fish stocks amounted to 12,856,622 lb. Frozen Fresh and 12,702 lb. Frozen Smoked (not including fillets).

Quantities of other fish reported as frozen during October 1940 were 2,301,053 lb.
