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## STORAGE HOLDINGS OF FISH, MARCH 1, 1940.

ALI FISH.
The inclusion of "Dried, Pickled and Salted" fish has boen
disoontinued. Stocks of all frozen fish on Maroh 1, 1940 totalled 20.3 million $1 b$. Including an estimate of 575 thousand Ib. Frozen Fresh and 113 thousand 1b. Frozen Smoked for firms failing to report on time. Of this total 18.6 million lb. were Frozen Fresh and 1.7 million Ib. Frozen Smoked. Comparing these classifioations there were 2.7 million lb. less Frozen Fresh stocks and 429 thousand lb. less stocks of Frozen Smoked than last year. Compared with last month's revised figures there was a deorease on March 1, 1940 of 22.3 per cent Frozen Fresh and of 23.6 per cent Frozen Smoked.

The a pparent net "Out-of-Storage" movement of frozen fish during February 1940 was 5.9 million 1b. as compared with a similar movement of 6.4 m1111on 1b. for the same month last year.

COD
Stocks of frozen Cod reported were $1,319,076 \mathrm{lb}$. of which $2,310,963$
1b. wore Frozen Fresh and 8,113 1b. Frozen Smoked (not including fillets) boing 50.8 per cont less than last month's frozen stock and 608 thousand ib. less than the frozen stocks of March 1, 1939.

The apparent net "Out-of-Storage" movement of all frozen Cod (except smoked fillets) was 1.4 million 1 b. as compared with a similar movenent of 910 thousand $1 b$. during February 1939, but the estimate is not included in this movement.

The quantity reported as frozen during February 1940 was 527,769
1b. as compared with $87,837 \mathrm{lb}$. for the same month last yoar.
HADDOCK. Stocks of frozen Haddock, as reported were $917,949 \mathrm{lb}$. of which 483,570 2b. were Frozen Fresh and 43 , 379 1b. Frozen Smoked (not including fillets). Haddock holdings are less by 37.5 per cent than last month's revised stocks and 665 thousand 1 b . less than at the same date a year ago.

There was an apparent net "Out-of-Storage" movement of 551 thousand 1b. In Janusry as compared with a similar movement of 1,082 thousand $1 b$. dur ing Fobruary 1939, not including the estimate for firms not reporting on time.

There were $530,097 \mathrm{lb}$. reported as frozen during February, being $284,672 \mathrm{Ib}$. more than the quantity reportod as frozen last year for the same month.

FILEETS. Frozen Smoked fillets of Cod, Haddock and other fish are now given in one quantity. These amounted to $723,828 \mathrm{lb}$. as compared w1th 914,69416 . for March 1 , 1939 and $1,217,376 \mathrm{Ib}$. last month.

The quantity frozen during February 1940 was 463,805 2b.
SALMON.
Frozen Salmon holdings, as reported, were $2,095,559$ ib. consisting of $2,080,273$ 1b. Frozen Fresh and 15,286 1b. Frozen Smoked. These frozen stocks were 2.5 million $1 b$. Iess than at the same date last year and 47.4 per cent less than the stocks of a month ago.

The apparent not withdrawals during February were 1.9 million $1 b$. as oompared with withdrawals of 1.6 million $1 b$. during the same month in 1939 . The Fobruary 1940 withdrawals do not take into consideration stocks of firms that falled to report on time.

SEA HERRING.
The total reported frozen stocks of Herring, including kippers,
were $5,898,2461 \mathrm{~b}$. as compared with $4,688,000$ 2b. last year. They are 3.4 per oent more than the revised figures for February 1, 1940.

The quantities frozen during February 1940 were reported as $1,333,165 \mathrm{lb}$. as compared with freezings of $536,280 \mathrm{lb}$. for February 1939.
OTHER. All other frozen fish stocks, including Hake, Cusk and Pollock.
smounted to 8,613,620 1b. Frozen Fresh and 12,049 1b. Frozen
Smoked (not including fillets).
Quantities of other fish frozon during February 1940 were 234,524 1b.
