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COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS OF FISH, MAY 1, 1940

ALL FISH.
Stocks of all frozen fish on May 1, 1940 totalled 14,5 miliion $1 b$. including an estimate of 674 thousand 1 b . Frozen Fresh and 44 thousand lb. Frozen Smoked for firms failing to report on time. Of this total 12.3 million 1b, were Frozen Fresh and 2.2 million lb. Frozen Smoked. Comparing these classifications there were 4.2 million $1 b$. less Frozen Fresh stocks and $184_{s}$ thousand lb. more stocks of Frozen Smoked than last year. Compared with last month's revised figures there was a decrease on May 1, 1940 of 12.4 per cent Frozen Fresh and an increase of 29.6 per cent Frozen Smokod.

The apparent net "Out-of-Storage" movement of frozen fish during April 1940 was 1.2 million 1 b . as compared with a similar movement of 2.6 million $1 b$. for the same month last year.

There were 625,008 1 b , reported as frozen during ispril, being 88, 224 lb . less than the quantity reported as frozen last year for the same month.

FILLETS. Frozen Smoked fillets of Cod, Haddock and other fish, as reported, May 1, 1939 and 1,008,048 1b. last month.

The quantity reported as frozen during ipril 1940 was 1,001,118 1 b .
SiIMON. Frozen Salmon holdings, as roported, were 443,691 1b., consisting mozen stock were of $424,386 \mathrm{lb}$. Frozen Fresh the les , 305 lb . Frozen Smoked. Theso cent less than the stocks of a month ago.

The apparent net withdrawals durime April were 371 thousand $1 b$. as oompared with withdrawals of 1.2 miliion 1 b . during the same month in 1939. The spril 1940 withdrawals do not take into consideration the stocks of firms that failed to report on tim.

SEA HERRING. The total reported frozen stocks of Herring, inciuding Kippers, are 28. 6 per cont less than the revised figuros for April 1, 1940.

The quantities reported as frozen during April 1940 were reported as $11,387 \mathrm{lb}$. as compared with freezings of $1,765 \mathrm{lb}$. for April 1939.

OTHER.
All other frozon fish stocks amounted to 6,230,721 Ib. Frozon Fresh and $39,227 \mathrm{ib}$. Frozen Smoked (not including fillets).
Quantities of other fish reported as frozen during ipril 1940
were $992,626^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{Ib}$.
