COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS OF FISH, SEPTEMBER 1, 1940

ALL FISH.

Stocks of all frozen fish on September 1, 1940 totalled 32.3

million lb. including an estimate of 8.2 million lb. Frozen Fresh
and 1.2 million lb. Frozen Smoked for firms failing to report on time. Of this total
30.2 million lb. were Frozen Fresh and 2.1 million lb. Frozen Smoked. Comparing those
classifications there were 4.6 million lb. less Frozen Fresh stocks and 261 thousand lb.
less stocks of Frozen Smoked than last year. Compared with last month's revised figures
there was an increase on September 1, 1940 of 10.3 per cent. Frozen Fresh and a docrease
of 13.5 per cent. Frozen Smoked.

The apparent net "Into-Storage" movement of frozen fish during August 1940 was 2.5 million 1b. as compared with a similar movement of 4.2 million 1b. for the same month last year.

Stocks of frozen Cod reported were 1,602,519 lb. of which 1,598,014 lb. were Frozen Fresh and 4,505 lb. Frozen Smoked (not including fillets), but the large estimate of all fish is not calculated for each kind.

The quantity reported as frezen frosh during August, 1940 was 1,700,886 lb. as compared with 778,725 lb. for the same month last year.

Stocks of frozen Haddock, as reported, were 663,568 lb. of which 527,048 lb. were Frozen Fresh and 136,520 lb. Frozen Smoked (not including fillets).

There were 215,246 lb. reported as frezen during August being 163 thousand lb. less than the quantity reported as frezen last year for the same month.

FILLETS.

Frozen Smoked fillets of Cod, Haddock and other fish, as

reported, amounted to 381,920 lb. as compared with 1,242,493 lb.

for September 1, 1939 and 1,338,844 lb. last month, but the estimate must include a large quantity of fillets.

The quantity reported as frozen during August 1940 was 4,610 1b.

SALMON.

Frozen Salmon holdings, as reported, were 4,233,300 lb., consisting of 4,228,947 lb. Frozen Fresh and 4,353 lb. Frozen Smoked.

The quantity reported as frozen during the month was 3,175,987

lb.

SEA HERRING.

The total reported frezen stocks of Herring, including Kippers, were 5,132,802 lb. as compared with 6,011,969 lb. last year, and 5,350,720 last menth.

The quantities reported as frozen during August 1940 amounted to 2,123,320 lb. as compared with freezings of 1,815,740 lb. for August 1939.

OTHER.

All other frozen fish stocks amounted to 10,921,104 lb. Frozen
Fresh and 15,123 lb. Frozen Smoked (not including fillets).

Quantities of other fish reported as frozen during August 1940 were 2,213,857 lb.
