COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS OF FISH, DECEMBER 1, 1941

ALL FISH

Stocks of all frozen fish on December 1, 1941 totalled 35.2 million lb. including an estimate of 1.1 million lb. Frozen Fresh and 118,000 lb. Frozen Smoked for firms failing to report on time. Of this total 32.4 million lb. were Frozen Fresh and 2.8 million lb. Frozen Smoked. Comparing these classifications there were 4.6 million lb. less Frozen Fresh stocks and 600 thousand lb. more stocks of Frozen Smoked than last year. Compared with last month's revised figures there were decreases on December 1, 1941 of 8.3 per cent Frozen Fresh and 7.2 per cent. Frozen Smoked.

The apparent net "Out-of-Storage" movement of frozen fish during November 1941 was 3.1 million lb. as compared with a similar movement of 166 thousand lb. for the same month last year.

C O D

Stocks of frozen Cod reported were 3,058,546 lb. of which 3,051,698 lb. were Frozen Fresh and 6,848 lb. Frozen Smoked (not including fillets).

The apparent net "Into-Storage" movement of all frozen Cod (except smoked fillets) was 198 thousand lb. as compared with a similar movement of 303 thousand lb. during November 1940, but the estimate is not included in this movement.

The quantity reported as frozen during November 1941 was 1,532,159 lb. as compared with 1,807,284 lb. for the same month last year.

HADDOCK

Reported stocks of frozen Haddock, were 862,569 lb. of which 622,603 lb. were Frozen Fresh and 239,966 lb. Frozen Smoked (not including fillets). Haddock holdings were more by 2.4 per cent than last month's revised stocks and 130 thousand lb. more than at the same date a year ago.

There was an apparent net "Into-Storage" movement of 169 thousand lb. in November (not including the estimate for firms failing to report on time) as compared with an "Out-of-Storage" movement of 159 thousand lb. during November 1940.

There were 576,096 lb. reported as frozen during November 1941, being 278 thousand lb. more than the quantity reported as frozen last year for the same month.

FILLETS

Frozen Smoked fillets of Cod, Haddock and other fish, as reported amounted to 1,423,064 lb., as compared with 1,036,099 lb. for December 1, 1940 and 1,618,512 lb. last month.

The quantity reported as frozen during November 1941 was 748,533 lb.

SALMON

Frozen salmon holdings, as reported, were 8,328,583 lb. consisting of 8,320,608 lb. Frozen Fresh and 7,975 lb. Frozen Smoked. These frozen stocks were 2,734,429 lb. less than at the same date last year and 2.5 per cent more than the stocks of a month ago, but the estimate is not included in these calculations or in the storage movement following.

The apparent net "Into-Storage" movement during November was 208 thousand lb. as compared with a similar movement of 2.2 million lb. during the same month in 1940.

The quantity reported as frozen during November 1941 was 1,022,187 lb.

SEA HERRING

The total reported frozen stocks of Herring, including Kippers, were 7,306,839 lb. as compared with 8,753,102 lb. last year. They are 12.1 per cent less than the revised figures for November 1, 1941.

The quantities reported as frozen during November 1941 amounted to 1,008,418 lb. as compared with freezings of 750,616 lb. for November 1940.

OTHER

All other frozen fish stocks amounted to 12,902,053 lb. Frozen Fresh and 73,265 lb. Frozen Smoked (not including fillets). Quantities of other fish reported as frozen during November 1941 were 1,138,978 lb.
