COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS OF FISH, JUNE 1, 1941

ALL FISH

Stocks of all frozen fish on June 1, 1941 totalled 18.6 million 1b.

including an estimate of 831 thousand 1b. Frozen Fresh and 560 thousand
1b. Frozen Smoked for firms failing to report on time. Of this total 16 million 1b. were
Frozen Fresh and 2.6 million 1b. Frozen Smoked. Comparing these classifications there
were 1.3 million 1b. more Frozen Fresh stocks and 479 thousand 1b. more stocks of Frozen
Smoked than last year. Compared with last month's revised figures there was a decrease
on June 1, 1941 of 9.3 per cent Frozen Fresh and an increase of 18.5 per cent Frozen
Smoked.

The apparent net "Out-of-Storage" movement of frozen fish during May 1941 was 1.2 million 1b. as compared with an "Into-Storage" movement of 2.5 million 1b. for the same month last year.

Stocks of frozen Cod reported were 1,301,037 lb. of which 1,791,800 lb. were Frozen Fresh and 9,237 lb. Frozen Smoked (not including fillets).

The apparent net "Out-of-Storage" movement of all frozen Cod (except smoked fillets) was 1.9 million lb. as compared with an "Into-Storage" movement of 200 thousand lb. during May 1940 but the estimate is not included in this movement.

The quantity reported as frozen during May 1941 was 1,210,002 lb. as compared with 1,581,330 lb. for the same month last year.

Reported stocks of frozen Haddock, were 702,035 1b. of which 453,772 1b. were Frozen Fresh and 248,263 1b. Frozen Smoked (not including fillets). Haddock holdings were less by 25 per cent than last month's revised stocks, and 84 thousand 1b. more than at the same date a year ago.

There was an apparent net "Out-of-Storage" movement of 232 thousand lb. in May (not including the estimate for firms failing to report on time) as compared with an "Into-Storage" movement of 25 thousand lb. during May 1940.

There were 85,604 lb. reported as frozen during May 1941 being 367,055 lb. less than the quantity reported as frozen last year for the same month.

FILLETS

Frozen Smoked fillets of Cod, Haddock and other fish, as reported, amounted to 1,507,930 lb. as compared with 1,423,645 lb. for June 1, 1940 and 1,391,507 lb. last month.

The quantity reported as frozen during May 1941 was 685,222 1b.

Frozen Salmon holdings, as reported, were 1,678,030 lb., consisting of 1,673,933 lb. Frozen Fresh and 4,097 lb. Frozen Smoked. These frozen stocks were 1.3 million lb. more than at the same date last year and 15.7 per cent less than the stocks of a month ago, but the estimate is not included in these calculations or in the storage movement following.

The apparent net "Out-of-Storage" movement during May was 313 thousand lb. as compared with a similar movement of 47 thousand lb. during the same month in 1940.

SEA HERRING

The total reported frozen stocks of Herring, including Kippers, were 2,946,244 lb. as compared with 3,930,455 lb. last year. They are 32 per gent less than the revised figures for May 1, 1941.

The quantities reported as frozen during May 1941 amounted to 504,848 lb. as compared with freezings of 1,241,640 lb. for May 1940.

OTHER

All other frozen fish stocks amounted to 8,460,229 lb. Frozen Fresh and 67,267 lb. Frozen Smoked (not including fillets).
