COLD STORAGE HOIDINGS OF FISH, SEETERBER 1, 1941
ALL FISH
Stooks of all frozen fish on Soptember l, 1941 totalled 36.8 million 1b. including an estimate of 1.8 million lb. Frozen Fresh and 147 thousand Ib. Frozen smoked for firms failing to report on time, or this total 31.9 million 1b. were Frozen Fresh and 4.9 million 1b. Frozen Smoked. Comparing these classifications there were 1.2 million lb , more Frozen Fresh stocks and 2.7 million 1 b . more stocks of Frozen Smoked than last year. Compared with last month's revised figures there was an increase on September 2, 1941 of 6.1 per cent Frozen Fresh and 40.3 per oent Frozen Smokeci.

The apparent net "Into-storage" movement of frozen fish during August 1941 was 3.3 million 13 . as compared with a similar movement of 3.0 million $1 b$, for the same month last year.

OOD Stocks of frozen Cod reported were 3,463,018 2b. of which 3,448,522 fillets).

The apparent net "IntomStorage" movement of all frozen Cod (excopt smoked fillets) was 220 thousand lb . as compared with an "Out-of-Storage" movement of 2.7 million 2 b . during August 1940 but the estimate is not included in this movement.

The quantity reported as frozen during August 1941 was 2,090,621 1b. as ocmpared with $2,702,488 \mathrm{ib}$. for the same month last year.

HADDOCK Reported stocks of frozen Haddock, were 1,021,807 1b. of which
720,579 1b, were Frozen Fresh and 301,228 1b. Frozen Smoked (not including fillets). Haddock holdings were less by 12.7 per cent than last month's revised stoaks and 29 thousand 2 b . less than at the same date a year ago.

There was an apparent net "Out-of-Storage" movement of 150 thousand 1b. in August (not inoluding the estimate for firms failing to report on time) as compared with a similar movement of 271 thousand 1b. during August 1940 .

There were $339,353 \mathrm{lb}$, reported as frozen during August 1941 being 236 thousand 1 b . less than the quantity reported as frozon last year for the same month.

FILLETS Frozen Smoked fillets of Cod, Haddock and other fish, as reported amounted to $1,919,320 \mathrm{lb}$. as compared with $723,973 \mathrm{lb}$. for September 1, 19А0 and 2,327,490 1b, last month.

The quantity reported as frozen during August 1941 was $308,316 \mathrm{lb}$.
SAIMON Frozen Salmon holdings, as reported, were 3, 494,331 IV. consisting of $3,488,938 \mathrm{lb}$. Frozen Fresh and 5, 893 1b, Frozen Smoked. These frozen stooks were $931,215 \mathrm{lb}$. less than at the sane date last year and 14.6 per cont more than the stocks of a month ago, but the estimate is not included in these calculations or in the storage movement following.

The apparent net "Into-storage" movement during Argust was 449 thousand $2 b$. as compared with a similar movement of 2.1 million $1 b$. during the same month in 1940 .

The quantity reportod as frozen during August 1941 was 1,715,119 1b.
13: MERELVG The total renorted frozen stocks of Herring, including Kippers, were $10,575,258$ 1b as compared with $10,113,869 \mathrm{lb}$. last year. They are 26.5002 out aurs than the revised figures for August 1, 1941.

The quantitios roported as frozen during August 1941 smounted to 4, $80,521 \mathrm{lh}$. as chavered with freezings of $5,864,984 \mathrm{lb}$. for August 1940.

OTHER
All other frozen fish stocks amounted to 14,362,766 1b. Frozen Fresh and $15,163 \mathrm{lb}$. Frozen Smoked (not including fillets). Guantities of other fish reported as frozen during Allust 1941 wore $1,957,376$ ib.
