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## COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS OF FISH, MARCH $1,13 \pm 2$

ALL FISH
Stocks of all frozer fish on March 1, 1342 totalled 19.5 million 1 b . including an estimato of 2 million lb . Frozen Fresh and 240 thousand 1 b. Frozon Smoked for firms failing to report on time. Of this total 10.5 million 1b. wero Frozen Fresh and 1.0 million lb. Frozen Smoked. There were 2.5 millioh 1b. less Frozen Fresh stocks and 341 thousand lb. less stocks of Frozen Smoked than last y,ar. Compared with last month's rovised figures there were decreases on March 1, 1942 of 14.4 per cent Frozen Fresh and 40.6 per cent Frozen Smoked.

The apparent net "Out-of-Storage" movement of frozen fish during February was 3.8 million $l b$. as compared with a similar movement of 6.4 million lb . for the same month last yenr.

COD Stocks of frozen Cod were 763,576 lb . of which 757,977 lb . fillets).

The apparent net "Out-of-Storage" movement of all frozen Cod (excopt smoked fillets) was 534 thousand 16 . as compared with a similar movement of 733 thousand 1b. during February 10 1 1。

The quantity reported as frozen during February was 462,168 lb. as compared with $1,252,445 \mathrm{lb}$. for the same month last year.

HADDOCK Stocks of frozen Haddock wore $355,375 \mathrm{lb}$. of which $237,314 \mathrm{lb}$.
wore Frosen Fresh and $113,061 \mathrm{lb}$. Frozen Smoked (not including fillets). Haddock holdings were loss by 43.8 per cent than last month's revised stocks and 317 thousand 1 b . less than at the same date a year ago.

There was on apparent net "Out-of-Storage" movement of 340 thousand 1 b . in February as compared with a similar movement of $\&_{s}$ thousand 1 b . during February 1941.

There were 116,424 lb. reported ns frozen during February 1942 , being $689,444 \mathrm{lb}$. less than the quantity reported as frozon last year for the same month. FILLETS Frozen Smoked fillets of Cod, Haddock and other fish, amounted and $821,010 \mathrm{lb}$. last month. to $363,522 \mathrm{lb}$. as compared with $463,367 \mathrm{lb}$. for March 1, 1341

SAIMON Frozen salmon holdings were $3,673,355 \mathrm{lb}$. consisting of 3,641,151 1b. Frozen Fresh and $32,23 \times 16$. Frozen Smoked. These frozen stocks were $1,262,403 \mathrm{lb}$. less than at the same date last year and 32.9 per cont less than the stocks of a month ago.

Tho apparent net "Out-of-Storage" movement during February was 1.8 million lb . as compared with a similar movement of 2.5 million lb . during the same month in 1941.

SEA HERRING
The totnl frozen stocks of Herring, including Kippers, were
6,730,103 1b. as compared with $5,395,818 \mathrm{lb}$. last year. They are 16 per cent more than the revised figures for February 1, 1342.

The quantities reported as frozen during Rebruary 1342 amounted to $2,236,002 \mathrm{lb}$. as compared with freezings of $402,105 \mathrm{lb}$. for February 1341 .
OTHER All other frozen fish stocks nmounted to 7, $553,915 \mathrm{lb}$. Frozen Quantities of other fish reported as frozen during Feb. 1942 were $729,5621 b$. 10 fillets).
