## COLD STORAGE HOLDIIGS OF FISH, APRIL 1, 1942.

ALL FISH
Stocks of all frozen fish in Canada on April 1, 1942 amounted to 18.2 million lb. of which 17.4 million lb. were Frozen Fresh and 790 thousand Ib. Frozen Smoked. These figures include estimates of 1.3 million lb. Frozen Fresh and 38 thousand 1 b . Frozen Smoked for firms failing to report on time. These holdings are less by 1.8 million $1 b$. Frozen Fresh and 605 thousand lb. Frozen Smoked than at April 1, 1941. Compared with March l, 1942 figures they are less by 7.5 per cent Frozen Fresh and 12.6 per cont Frozen Smoked.

The apparent net "Out-of-Storage" movement for all classifications was 1.5 million 1 b, as compared with a similar movement of 1.6 million lb. for March 1941.

COD
Holdings of frozen Cod were 1,093,600 lb, consisting of $1,087,355 \mathrm{lb}$. Frozen Fresh and 6, 245 lb . Frozen Smoked (fillets not included).

The apparent net increase during March was 315 thousand Ib. as compared with an increase of 548 thousand Ib. during March 1941.

The quantity reported as frozen during March was $1,135,644 \mathrm{Ib}$. as compared with $1,712,191 \mathrm{lb}$. for the same month in 1941.

HADDOCK Stocks of frozen Haddock, totalled 492.856 Ib , of whioh 313.052 Ib. were Frozen Fresh and 179,804 1b. Frozen Smoked (not inoluding fillets). Haddock holdings were 157 thousand $1 b$. less than at the same date last year and 43 per cent more than the stocks on March 1, 1942. There was an apparent net "Into-Storage" movement of 148 thousand $1 b$. in March 1942 as compared with an opposite movement of 23 thousand lb. during March 1941. Thore were 600,131 1b. reported as having been frozen during March 1942 while for March 1941 the freezings were 551,419 Ib.

FILLETS Frozen Smoked Pillets of Cod Haddock and other fish amounted to $\overline{269,13} 8 \mathrm{lb}$. as compared with $673,859 \mathrm{lb}$. last year and $309,611 \mathrm{lb}$.
last month.
There were 529,970 1b. reported as frozen during March, 1942.

SALMON
Frozen Salmon holdings at April 1, 1942 were $2,955,498 \mathrm{lb}$. They are $363,409 \mathrm{lb}$. less as compared with last year and 17.6 per cent
less as oompared with last month.
The apparent net withdrawals during March were 630 thousand lb. as compared with withdrawals of 1.6 million 1 l . during the same month in 1941 .

Freezings of this commodity during the month totalled 60.550 lb .

## SEA FERRING

Frozen stocks of herring, including Kippers, were 6,194,600 1b being Fresh 5,904,561 Ib. and Smoked 290,039 lb. Last year at the same date the combined figures were $6,025,086 \mathrm{lb}$. This month's stocks are 8.9 per cent less than those of last month.

The quantity reported as frozen during March was 741,783 1b. as compared with freezings of $1,386,935 \mathrm{Ib}$. for March 1941.

OTHER
Other Frozen fish stocks amounted to 7,182,158 1b. Frozen Fresh and $\frac{40,236}{} 1 \mathrm{~b}$. Frozon Smoked. (not including fillets).
