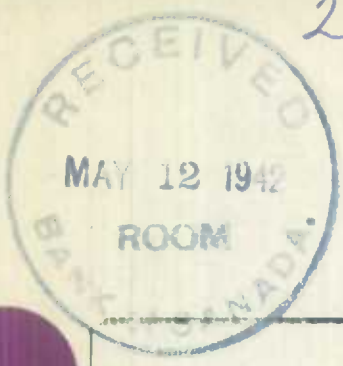

COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS OF FISH, MAY 1, 1942

ALL FISH

Stocks of all frozen fish in Canada on May 1, 1942 amounted to 15,3 million lb. of which 14,4 million lb. were Frozen Fresh and 926 thousand lb. Frozen Smoked. These figures include estimates of 397 thousand lb. Frozen Fresh and 3 thousand lb. Frozen Smoked for firms failing to report on time. These holdings are less by 3.3 million lb. Frozen Fresh and 1,2 million lb. Frozen Smoked than at May 1, 1941. Compared with April 1, 1942 figures they are less by 10.2 per cent. Frozen Fresh and more by 18.8 per cent. Frozen Smoked.

The apparent net "Out-of-Storage" movement for all classifications was 1.5 million lb. as compared with a similar movement of 807 thousand lb. for April 1941.

C O D

Holdings of frozen Cod were 2,443,200 lb. consisting of 2,438,287 lb. Frozen Fresh and 4,913 lb. Frozen Smoked (fillets not included).

The apparent net increase during April was 1.3 million lb. which was the same increase as that of April 1941.

The quantity reported as frozen during April was 2,254,780 lb. as compared with 1,944,782 lb. for the same month in 1941.

HADDOCK

Stocks of frozen Haddock, totalled 438,758 lb. of which 297,439 lb. were Frozen Fresh and 141,319 lb. Frozen Smoked (not including fillets). Haddock holdings were 495 thousand lb. less than at the same date last year and 11.2 per cent. less than the stocks on April 1, 1942. There was an apparent net "Out-of-Storage" movement of 55 thousand lb. in April 1942 as compared with an opposite movement of 284 thousand lb. during April 1941.

There were 183,425 lb. reported as having been frozen during April 1942 while for April 1941 the freezings were 630,931 lb.

FILLETTS

Frozen smoked Fillets of Cod Haddock and other fish amounted to 576,986 lb. as compared with 1,393,014 lb. last year and 268,233 lb. last month.

There were 1,023,703 lb. reported as frozen during April 1942.

SALMON

Frozen Salmon holdings at May 1, 1942 were 1,658,336 lb. They are 334 thousand lb. less as compared with last year and 31 per cent. less as compared with last month.

The apparent net withdrawals during April were 746 thousand lb. as compared with withdrawals of 1.3 million lb. during the same month in 1941.

Freezings of this commodity during the month totalled 25,975 lb.

SEA HERRING

Frozen stocks of herring, including Kippers, were 5,013,313 lb. being Fresh 4,837,865 lb. and Smoked 175,448 lb. Last year at the same date the combined figures were 4,336,925 lb. This month's stocks are 18.6 per cent. less than those of last month.

The quantity reported as frozen during April was 132,162 lb. as compared with freezings of 231,185 lb. for April 1941.

OTHER

Other Frozen fish stocks amounted to 5,151,031 lb. Frozen Fresh and 16,978 lb. Frozen Smoked. (not including fillets). All other fish reported as having been frozen during April were 451,997 lb.
