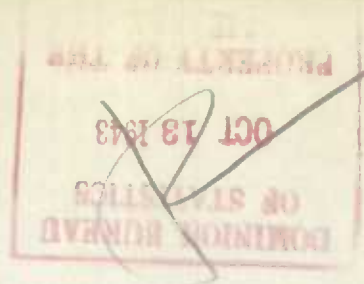

COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS OF FISH, OCTOBER 1, 1943

ALL FISH

Stocks of all frozen fish in Canada on October 1 amounted to 34.6 million lb., of which 32.7 million lb. were Frozen Fresh and 1.9 million lb. Frozen Smoked. In these figures estimates of 6.3 million lb. Frozen Fresh and 187 thousand lb. Frozen Smoked are included for firms failing to report on time. These holdings are less by 1.5 million lb. Frozen Fresh and 67 thousand lb. Frozen smoked than those at October 1, 1942. Compared with September 1, 1943 figures they are less by 5.2 per cent Frozen Fresh and 3.9 per cent Frozen Smoked.

The apparent net "Out-of-Storage" movement for all classifications was 1.9 million lb. as compared with an opposite movement of 362 thousand lb. for September 1942.

C O D

Holdings of frozen Cod were 7,624,004 lb. consisting of 7,602,204 lb. Frozen Fresh, and 21,800 lb. Frozen Smoked (fillets not included).

The apparent net decrease during September was 710 thousand as compared with an increase of 826 thousand lb. in September 1942.

The quantity reported as frozen during September was 4,770,972 lb., as compared with 2,716,319 lb. for the same month in 1942.

HADDOCK

Stocks of frozen Haddock totalled 1,189,614 lb. of which 1,107,640 lb. were Frozen Fresh and 81,974 lb. Frozen Smoked (not including Fillets). Haddock holdings were 406 thousand lb. more than at the same date last year and 20 per cent less than the stocks on September 1, 1943. There was an apparent net "Out-of-Storage" movement of 297 thousand lb. in September 1943 as compared with a similar movement of 156 thousand lb. during September 1942.

There were 225,720 lb. reported as having been frozen during September 1943 while for the corresponding month in 1942 the freezings were 178,768 lb.

FILLETS

Frozen smoked fillets of Cod, Haddock and other fish amounted to 625,024 lb. as compared with 920,244 lb. last year and 648,724 lb. last month.

There were 257,009 lb. reported as frozen during September 1943.

SALMON

Frozen Salmon holdings at October 1 were 3,853,799 lb. They are 1.9 thousand lb. more than last year and 53.9 per cent more than last month.

The apparent net increase during September was 1.4 million lb. as compared with an increase of 58 thousand lb. during the same month in 1942.

SEA HERRING

Frozen stocks of herring, including Kippers, were 9,553,696 lb., being Fresh 8,447,381 lb. and Smoked 1,106,315 lb. Last year at the same date the combined figures were 11,139,666 lb. This month's stocks show a decrease of 1.3 million lb. under last month's holdings.

The quantity reported as frozen during September was 1.6 million lb., as compared with freezings of 856 thousand lb. for September 1942.

OTHER

Other Frozen stocks amounted to 11,724,422 lb. Frozen Fresh and 35,992 lb. Frozen Smoked, (not including fillets).

All other fish reported as having been frozen during September were 1,576,307 lb.
