

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COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS OF FISH, APRIL 1, 1943

ALL FISH

Stocks of all frozen fish in Canada on April 1 amounted to 14.6 million lb., of which 13.7 million lb. were Frozen Fresh and 0.9 million lb. Frozen Smoked. In these figures estimates of 1.2 million lb. Frozen Fresh and 18 thousand lb. Frozen Smoked are included for firms failing to report on time. These holdings are less by 2.3 million lb. Frozen Fresh and more by 92 thousand lb. Frozen Smoked than those at April 1, 1942. Compared with March 1, 1943 figures they are less by 19.7 per cent Frozen Fresh and 19.2 per cent Frozen Smoked.

The apparent net "Out-of-Storage" movement for all classifications was 3.6 million lb. as compared with a similar movement of 3.0 million lb. for March 1942.

C O D

Holdings of frozen Cod were 1,610,069 lb. consisting of 1,604,674 lb. Frozen Fresh, and 5,395 lb. Frozen Smoked (fillets not included).

The apparent net increase during March was 69 thousand lb. as compared with an increase of 315 thousand lb. in March 1942.

The quantity reported as frozen during March was 1,090,345 lb., as compared with 1,185,794 lb. for the same month in 1942.

HADDOCK

Stocks of frozen Haddock totalled 512,910 lb., of which 434,218 lb. were Frozen Fresh and 78,692 lb. Frozen Smoked (not including fillets). Haddock holdings were 19 thousand lb. more than at the same date last year and 27 per cent less than the stocks on March 1, 1943. There was an apparent net "Out-of-Storage" movement of 190 thousand lb. in March 1943 as compared with an opposite movement of 150 thousand lb. during March 1942.

There were 393,270 lb. reported as having been frozen during March 1943 while for the corresponding month in 1942 the freezings were 600,131 lb.

FILLETS

Frozen smoked fillets of Cod, Haddock and other fish amounted to 455,422 lb. as compared with 268,233 lb. last year and 430,750 lb. last month.

There were 885,894 lb. reported as frozen during March.

SALMON

Frozen Salmon holdings at April 1 were 1,595,930 lb. They are 309 thousand lb. less than last year and 50 per cent less than last month.

The apparent net decrease during March was 1.6 million lb. as compared with a decrease of 1.2 million lb. during the same month in 1942.

SEA HERRING

Frozen stocks of herring, including Kippers, were 4,745,651 lb. being Fresh 4,465,413 lb. and Smoked 280,238 lb. Last year at the same date the combined figures were 6,149,703 lb. This month's stocks show an increase of 375 thousand lb. over last month's holdings.

The quantity reported as frozen during March was 1.7 million lb., as compared with freezings of 741 thousand lb. for March 1942.

OTHER

Other Frozen fish stocks amounted to 5,626,939 lb. Frozen Fresh and 31,796 lb. Frozen Smoked, (not including fillets).

All other fish reported as having been frozen during March were 784,299 lb.
