

COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS OF FISH, JULY 1, 1943

ALL FISH

Stocks of all frozen fish in Canada on July 1 amounted to 17.5 million lb., of which 16.6 million lb. were Frozen Fresh and

918 thousand lb. Frozen Smoked. In these figures estimates of 1.1 million lb. Frozen Fresh and 49 thousand lb. Frozen Smoked are included for firms failing to report on time. These holdings are less by 9.1 million lb. Frozen Fresh and by 416 thousand lb. Frozen Smoked than those at July 1, 1942. Compared with June 1, 1943 figures they are more by 14.6 per cent Frozen Fresh and less by 18.6 per cent Frozen Smoked.

The apparent net "Into-Storage" movement for all classifications was 2.0 million lb. as compared with a similar movement of 7.7 million lb. for June 1942.

C O D

Holdings of frozen Cod were 5,139,641 lb. consisting of 5,130,597 lb. Frozen Fresh, and 9,044 lb. Frozen Smoked (fillets not included).

The apparent net increase during June was 1.3 million lb. as compared with an increase of 1.6 million lb. in June 1942.

The quantity reported as frozen during June was 3,311,990 lb., as compared with 2,717,054 lb. for the same month in 1942.

HADDOCK

Stocks of frozen Haddock totalled 1,291,019 lb. of which 1,229,671 lb. were Frozen Fresh and 61,348 lb. Frozen Smoked (not including fillets). Haddock holdings were 316 thousand lb. more than at the same date last year and 74.1 per cent more than the stocks on June 1, 1943. There was an apparent net "Into-Storage" movement of 550 thousand lb. in June 1943 as compared with a similar movement of 614 thousand lb. during June 1942.

There were 2,177,087 lb. reported as having been frozen during June 1943 while for the corresponding month in 1942 the freezings were 937,847 lb.

FILLETS

Frozen Smoked fillets of Cod, Haddock and other fish amounted to 692,844 lb. as compared with 981,429 lb. last year and 844,173 lb. last month.

There were 632,517 lb. reported as frozen during June.

SALMON

Frozen Salmon holdings at July 1 were 599,304 lb. They are 1.2 million lb. less than last year and 41.1 per cent more than last month.

The apparent net increase during June was 175 thousand lb. as compared with an increase of 241 thousand lb. during the same month in 1942.

SEA HERRING

Frozen stocks of herring, including Kippers, were 1,217,508 lb. being Fresh 1,097,406 lb. and Smoked 120,102 lb. Last year at the same date the combined figures were 6,458,923 lb. This month's stocks show a decrease of 2.2 million lb. from last month's holdings.

The quantity reported as frozen during June was 182 thousand lb., as compared with freezings of 611 thousand lb. for June 1942.

OTHER

Other Frozen fish stocks amounted to 8,531,986 lb. Frozen Fresh and 30,523 lb. Frozen Smoked, (not including fillets).

All other fish reported as having been frozen during June were 3,937,398 lb.
