

### COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS OF FISH, SEPTEMBER 1, 1943

ALL FISH

Stocks of all frozen fish in Canada on September 1 amounted to 36 million 1b., of which 34 million 1b. were Frozen Fresh and

2 million 1b. Frozen Smoked. In these figures estimates of 2.5 million 1b. Frozen Fresh and 42 thousand lb Frozen Smoked are included for firms failing to report on time. These holdings are more by 151 thousand lb. Frozen Fresh and 80 thousand lb. Frozen smoked than those at September 1, 1942. Compared with August 1, 1943 figures they are more by 12.5 per cent Frozen Fresh and 20 1 per cent Frozen Smoked.

The apparent net "Into Storage" movement for all classifications was 4.1 million ib. as compared with a similar movement of 3.9 million lb. for August 1942.

COD

Holdings of frozen God were 7,973,546 lb. consisting of 7,955,984 lb. Frozen Fresh, and 17,562 lb. Frozen Smoked (fillets not included).

The apparent net decrease during August was 218 thousand lb. as compared with a decrease of 37 thousand 1b. in August 1942.

The quantity reported as frozen during August was 3,701,530 lb., as compared with 2,737,339 lb. for the same month in 1942.

HADDCCK

Stocks of frozen Haddock totalled 1,543,230 lb., of which 1,434,820 lb. were Frozen Fresh and 108,410 lb. Frozen Smoked (not including Fillets). Haddock holdings were 604 thousand lb, more than at the same date last year and 45.3 per cent less than the stocks on August 1, 1943. There was an apparent net "Out-of-Storage" movement of 73.3 thousand lb. in August 1943 as compared with an opposite movement of 62 thousand lb. during August 1942.

There were 598,501 lb. reported as having been frozen during August 1943 while for the corresponding month in 1942 the freezings were 460,890 lb.

FILLETS

Frozer smoked fillets of Cod, Haddock and other fish amounted to 656,869 lb. as compared with 872,283 lb. last year and 816,273 lb.

last month.

There were 122,192 lb. reported as frozen during August 1943.

SALMON

Frozen Salmon holdings at September 1 were 2,348,390 lb. They are 446 thousand 1b. less than last year and 80.7 per cent more than

last month.

The apparent net Increase during August was 1.0 million 1b, as compared with an increase of 789 thousand lb. during the same month in 1942.

SEA HERRING

Frozen stocks of herring, including Kippers, were 10,858,702 lb. being Fresh 9,727,643 lb. and Smoked 1,131,059 lb. Last year at the same date the combined figures were 12,245,565 lb. This month's stocks show an increase of 3 2 million 1b, over last month's revised holdings.

The quantity reported as frozen during August was 4.3 million lb., as compared with freezings of 4.0 million lb. for August 1942.

OTHER

Other Frozen stocks amounted to 12,617,955 lb. Frozen Fresh and 51,484 lb. Frozen Smoked, (not including fillets).

All other fish reported as having been frozen during August were

2,430.421 lb.

June 1 figures for Sea Herring should now read 4,845,948lb. and July 1 data should be. Sea Herring 4,735,982 lb. and Mackerel 1,928,555 lb.
