COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS OF FISH, JANUARY 1, 1944

ALL FISH

Stocks of all frozen fish in Canada on January 1 amounted to 33,190,973 lb., of which 31.3 million lb. were Frozen fresh and 1.9 million lb. Frozen Smoked. In these figures estimates of 6.2 million lb. Frozen Fresh and 603 thousand lb. Frozen Smoked are included for firms failing to report on time. These holdings are less by 5.2 million lb. Frozen Fresh and 621 thousand lb. Frozen Smoked than those at January 1, 1943. Compared with December 1, 1943 figures they are less by 8.9 per cent Frozen Fresh and 15.9 per cent Frozen Smoked.

The apparent net "Out-of-Storage" movement for all classifications was 3.1 million lb. as compared with a similar movement of 6.6 million lb. for January 1, 1943.

COD

Holdings of frozen Cod were 6,875,499 lb. consisting of 6,866,015 lb. Frozen Fresh, and 9,484 lb. Frozen Smoked (fillets not included).

The apparent net decrease during December was 437 thousand lb. as compared with a decrease of 798 thousand lb. in December 1942.

The quantity reported as frozen during December was 1,070,723 lb., as compared with 827,122 lb. for the same month in 1942.

HADDOCK

Stocks of frozen Haddock totalled 1,296,762 lb., of which 1,177,266 lb. were Frozen Fresh and 119,496 lb. Frozen Smoked (not including fillets). Haddock holdings were 497 thousand lb. more than at the same date last year and 1.2 per cent less than the stocks on December 1, 1943. There was an apparent net "Out-of-Storage" movement of 16.3 thousand lb. in December 1943 as compared with a similar movement of 146 thousand lb. during December 1942.

There were 273,375 lb. reported as having been frozen during December 1943 while for the corresponding month in 1942 the freezings were 295,554 lb.

FILLETS

Frozen smoked fillets of Cod, Haddock and other fish amounted to 647,996 lb. as compared with 490,180 lb. last year and 733,323 lb. last month.

There were 295,868 lb. reported as frozen during December 1943.

SALMON

Frozen Salmon holdings at January 1 were 8,640,184 lb. They are 2.2 million lb. more than last year and 11.0 per cent less than last month.

The apparent net decrease during December was 1.1 million lb. as compared with a decrease of 1.5 million lb. during the same month in 1942.

SEA HERRING

Frozen stocks of herring, including Kippers, were 6,547,063 lb. being Fresh 5,458,321 lb. and Smoked 1,088,742 lb. Last year at the same date the combined figures were 5,527,714 lb. This month's stocks show a decrease of 202 thousand lb. from last month's holdings.

The quantity reported as frozen during December was 999 thousand lb., as compared with freezings of 956 thousand lb. for December 1942.

OTHER

Other Frozen stocks amounted to 9,160,805 lb. Frozen Fresh and 22,664 lb. Frozen Smoked, (not including fillets).

All other fish reported as having been frozen during December were 1,023,908 lb.
