

COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS OF FISH, OCTOBER 1, 1944

ALL FISH

Stocks of all frozen fish in Canada on October 1 amounted to

42,895,276 lb., of which 40.8 million lb. were Frozen fresh
and 2.0 million lb. Frozen Smoked. In these figures estimates of 7.5 million lb. Frozen
Fresh and 235 thousand lb. Frozen Smoked are included for firms failing to report on time.
These holdings are more by 7.8 million lb. Frozen Fresh and 143 thousand lb. Frozen
Smoked than those at October 1, 1943. Compared with September 1, 1944 figures they are
higher by 6.1 per cent Frozen Fresh and lower by 12.2 per cent Frozen Smoked.

The apparent net "Into-Storage" movement for all classification was 2.1 million 1b., as compared with an opposite movement of 1.5 million 1b. for October 1943.

COD Moldings of frozen Cod were 8,811,598 lb. consisting of 8,805,939 lb. Frozen Fresh, and 5,659 lb. Frozen Smoked (fillets not included).

The apparent net increase during September was 914 thousand 1b. compared with an increase of 1.3 million 1b. in September 1943.

The quantity reported as frozen during September was 2,067,974 lb., as compared with 3,780,253 lb. for the same month in 1943.

HADDOCK

Stocks of frozen Haddock totalled 964,478 lb., of which
897,670 lb. were Frozen Fresh and 66,808 lb. Frozen Smoked
(not including fillets). Haddock holdings were 226 thousand lb. less than at the same
date last year and 2.3 per cent less than the stocks on September 1, 1944. There was an
apparent net "Out-of-Storage" movement of 23 thousand lb. in September 1944 as compared
with a similar movement of 296 thousand lb. during September 1943.

There were 180,913 lb. reported as having been frozen during September 1944 while for the corresponding month in 1943 the freezings were 225,720 lb. but some firms had not reported on time and no estimate is made of freezings.

FILLETS

Frozen smoked fillets of Cod, Haddock and other fish amounted to 1,069,431 lb. as compared with 636,794 lb. last year and 1,109,743 lb. last month.

There were 341,836 lb. reported as frozen during September 1944.

SALMON Frozen Salmon holdings at October 1 were 7,821,195 lb. They were 3.9 million lb. more than last year and 74.5 per cent more than last month.

The apparent net increase during September was 3.3 million 1b. es compared with an increase of 1.4 million 1b. during the same month in 1943.

Freezings during September were 2,341,848 lb. without any estimate.

Frozen stocks of herring, including Kippers, were 9,481,607 lb.

being Fresh 8,611,604 lb. and Imoked 869,945 lb. Last year at
the same date the combined figures were 10,289,287 lb. This month's stocks show a
decrease of 1.2 million lb. from last conth's holdings.

The quantity reported as frozen during September was 330 thousand 1b. as compared with freezings of 1.0 million 1b. for deptember 1843 but no ostimate is included.

Other Prozen stocks assumted to 11,720,620 lb. rozen 'resh and 26,347 lb. Prozen broked (not ireluding fillets)

All other fish reported as having been frozen during September were 1,501,322 lb. but some firms had not yet reported.
