## COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS OF FISH, JNE 1,1944

ALL FISH
Stocks of all frozen fish in Camada on June 1 amounted to 19,859,115 1b., of which 18,2 million 1b. were Frozen Frosh and 1.7 million 1b. Frozen Smoked. In these figures estimates of 1.8 million 1b Frozen Fresh and 127 thousand $1 b$. Frozen Smoked are included for firms failing to report on time. These holdings are more by 2.0 million 1 b . Frozen Fresh and 558 thousand 1 b . Frozen Smoked than those at June 1, 1943. Compared with liay 1, 1944 figures they ary more by 3.2 per cent Frozen Fresh and by 16.0 per cent Frozen Smoked.

The anparent net "Into-Storage" movement for all classifications was 793 thousand 1 lb . as compared wita a similar movement of 5.0 million 1 b . for June 1943.

COD
Holdings of frozen Cod were 4,997,765 consisting of 4,972,950 1b. Frozen Fresh and $24,315 \mathrm{ib}$. Frozen Smoked fililets not
included).
The apparent. net increase during May was 82 thousand 1 b . as comm pared with an increase of 1,5 miliion lo. in June 1943.

The quantity reported as frczen durling May was 2,914,680 lb, , as compared with 2,857.752 1b for the same month in 1943.

MADDOCK Stocks of frozen Haddock totall $\rightarrow 800.054 \mathrm{lb}$, of which
648,744 15. wo Frozen Fresh and 151, 310 ib. Frozen Smokei (not including fillats). Haddook hoidings were 62 thousand 1 b . more than at the same date last year and 18.5 per cent less than the stocks on May i. 1944 . There was an apparent net "OutwofiStorage" movement of 183 thousand L . in May 1944 as crmpared with a similar movement of 37 thousand Ib, during May 1943.

There were $191,4351 \mathrm{~b}$. reported as having been frozen during May 1944 while for the coresponding month in 1943 the freezings were $251,275 \mathrm{lb}$.

FIILIESS Frozen smoked fillets of Cod, Haddock and other fish amounted to $1,133,991 \mathrm{lb}$. as compared with $844,173 \mathrm{lb}$. last year and $823,454 \mathrm{Ib}$. last month。

There were $1,216,282 \mathrm{lb}$. reported as frozen during May 1944.
SALiON Frozen Salmon holdings at June 1, were 1, 195,234 1b. They are
771 thousand 1 lb . more than last year and 30.9 per cent less than
last month.
The apparent net decrease during liay was 535 thousand $l \mathrm{lb}$. as compared with a docreas of 335 thousand lb, durinp the same month in 1943,

SEA HERRING Frozen stocks of herring. including Kippers, were 4,097,635 1b. being Fresh $3,797,237 \mathrm{lb}$. and Smoked $300,398 \mathrm{lb}$. Last year at the same dat the combined figures ware $4,992,601 \mathrm{lb}$. This month's stocks show an increase of 1.4 million 1 b . from last month's holdings.

The quantity reported as frozen during May was $2,773,576 \mathrm{lb}$., as compared with freezings of 2.3 million $1 b_{\text {n }}$ for May 1943

OTHER Other Frozen stocks amounted to $7,583,966 \mathrm{lb}$. Frozen Fresh and $50,670 \mathrm{lb}$. Frozen Smoked, (not including fillets).
All other fish reported as having been frozen during May were $1,424,312 \mathrm{Ib}$.
