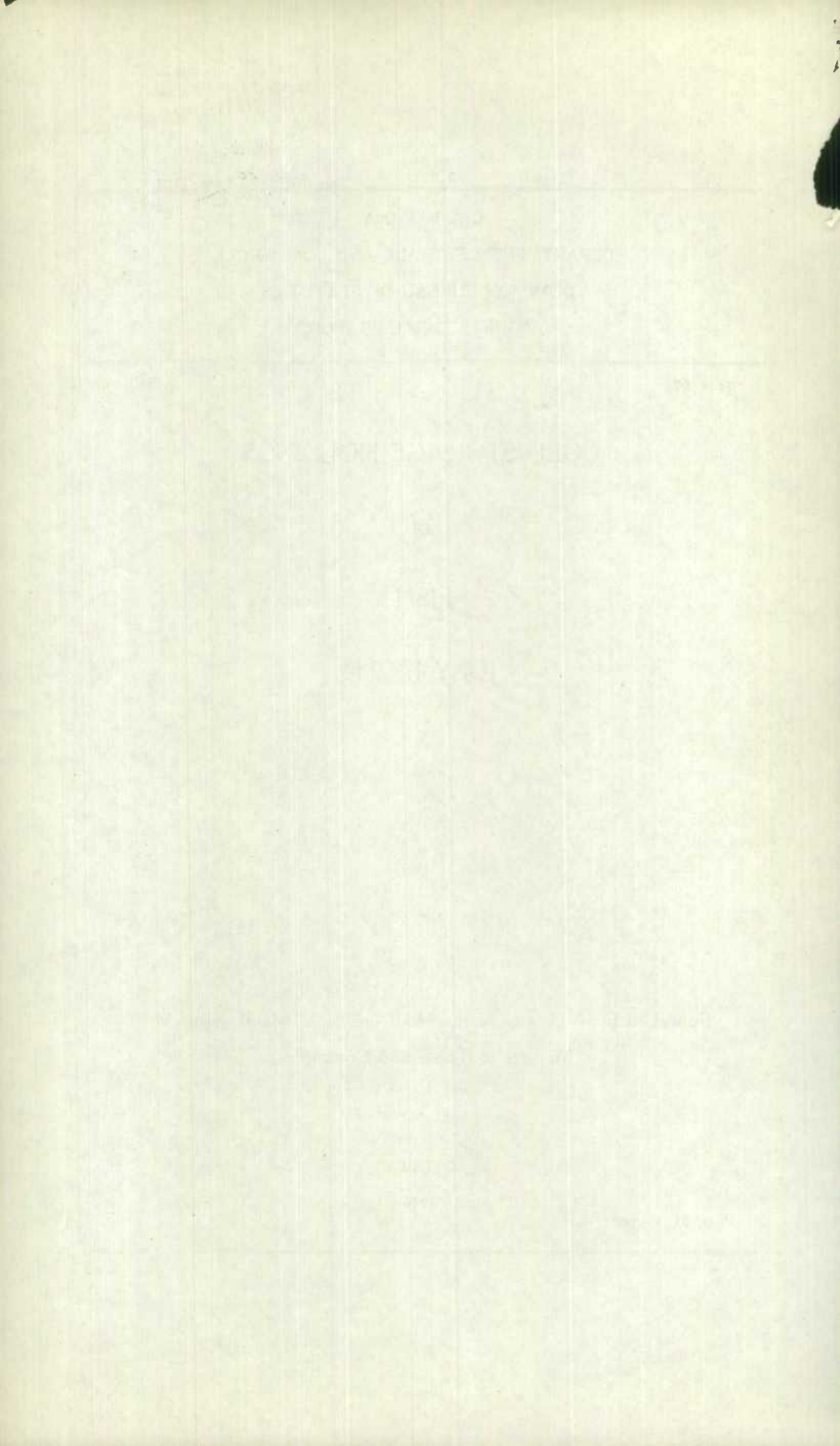

COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS OF FISH, JULY 1, 1944

ALL FISH

Stocks of all frozen fish in Canada on July 1 amounted to 26,819,847 lb., of which 24.8 million lb. were Frozen fresh and 2.0 million lb. Frozen Smoked. In these figures estimates of 3.5 million lb. Frozen Fresh and 307 thousand lb. Frozen Smoked are included for firms failing to report on time. These holdings are more by 3.0 million lb. Frozen Fresh and 1.0 million lb. Frozen Smoked than those at July 1, 1943. Compared with June 1, 1944 figures they are higher by 28 per cent Frozen Fresh and 10.9 per cent Frozen Smoked.

The apparent net "Into-Storage" movement for all classifications was 5.6 million lb. as compared with a similar movement of 5.4 million lb. for June 1, 1943.

COD

Holdings of frozen Cod were 7,958,809 lb. consisting of 7,949,752 lb. Frozen Fresh, and 9,057 lb. Frozen Smoked (fillets not included).

The apparent net increase during June was 2.4 million as compared with an increase of 1.3 million lb. in June 1943.

The quantity reported as frozen during June was 3,291,762 lb., as compared with 3,621,854 lb. for the same month in 1943.

HADDOCK

Stocks of frozen Haddock totalled 926,728 lb., of which 732,312 lb. were Frozen Fresh and 194,416 lb. Frozen Smoked (not including fillets). Haddock holdings were 464 thousand lb. less than at the same date last year and 14.5 per cent more than the stocks on June 1, 1944. There was an apparent net "Into-Storage" movement of 117 thousand lb. in June 1944 as compared with a similar movement of 652 thousand lb. during June 1943.

There were 336,634 lb. reported as having been frozen during June 1944 while for the corresponding month in 1943 the freezings were 1,311,079 lb., but some firms had not reported on time and no estimate is made of freezings.

FILLETS

Frozen smoked fillets of Cod, Haddock and other fish amounted to 1,541,457 lb. as compared with 740,252 lb. last year and 1,270,362 lb. last month.

There were 868,863 lb. reported as frozen during June 1944.

SALMON

Frozen Salmon holdings at July 1 were 1,161,617 lb. They were 539 thousand lb. more than last year and 3.5 per cent less than last month.

The apparent net decrease during June was 42 thousand lb. as compared with an increase of 199 thousand lb. during the same month in 1943.

SEA HERRING

Frozen stocks of herring, including Kippers, were 3,293,052 lb. being Fresh 3,054,175 lb. and Smoked 238,877 lb. Last year at the same date the combined figures were 4,407,201 lb. This month's stocks show a decrease of 1.3 million lb. from last month's holdings.

The quantity reported as frozen during June was 477 thousand lb. as compared with freezings of 246 thousand lb. for June 1943.

OTHER

Other Frozen stocks amounted to 11,892,796 lb. Frozen Fresh and 45,388 lb. Frozen Smoked, (not including fillets).

All other fish reported as having been frozen during June were 2,951,690 lb. but some firms had not yet reported.
