

COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS OF FISH, SEPTEMBER 1, 1944

ALL FISH

Stocks of all frozen fish in Canada on September 1 amounted to 38,274,293 lb., of which 36.2 million lb. were Frozen fresh and 2.0 million lb. Frozen Smoked. In these figures estimates of 2.9 million lb. Frozen Fresh and 34 thousand lb. Frozen Smoked are included for firms failing to report on time. These holdings are more by 1.7 million lb. Frozen Fresh and 85 thousand lb. Frozen Smoked than those at September 1, 1943. Compared with August 1, 1944 figures they are higher by 10.2 per cent Frozen Fresh and lower by 8.3 per cent Frozen Smoked.

The apparent net "Into-Storage" movement for all classifications was 3.2 million lb. as compared with a similar movement of 4.4 million lb. for September 1, 1943.

COD

Holdings of frozen Cod were 7,696,113 lb. consisting of 7,674,186 lb. Frozen Fresh, and 21,927 lb. Frozen Smoked (fillets not included).

The apparent net decrease during August was 27 thousand lb. as compared with an increase of 106 thousand lb. in August 1943.

The quantity reported as frozen during August was 5,715,468 lb., as compared with 4,363,990 lb. for the same month in 1943.

HADDOCK

Stocks of frozen Haddock totalled 876,981 lb., of which 817,570 lb. were Frozen Fresh and 59,411 lb. Frozen Smoked (not including fillets). Haddock holdings were 610 thousand lb. less than at the same date last year and 1.1 per cent less than the stocks on August 1, 1944. There was an apparent net "Out-of-Storage" movement of 10 thousand lb. in August 1944 as compared with a similar movement of 129 thousand lb. during August 1943.

There were 471,968 lb. reported as having been frozen during August 1944 while for the corresponding month in 1943 the freezings were 398,551 lb.

FILLETS

Frozen smoked fillets of Cod, Haddock and other fish amounted to 1,065,321 lb. as compared with 648,724 lb. last year and 1,231,497

lb. last month.

There were 251,913 1b. reported as frozen during August 1944.

SALMON

Frozen Salmon holdings at September 1 were 3,653,801 lb. They are 1.2 million lb. more than last year and 63.9 per cent more

than last month.

The apparent net increase during August was 1.4 million lb. as compared with an increase of 1.2 million lb. during the same month in 1943.

Freezings during August were 2,717,667 lb.

SEA HERRINC Frozen stacks of herring, including Kippers were 9,561,785 lb. being Fresh 8,744,733 lb. and Smoked 817,052 lb. Last year at the same date the combined figures were 10,884,599 lb. This month's stocks show an increase of 2 million lb. over last month's holdings.

The quantity reported as frozen during August was 4.2 million lb. as compared with freezings of 4.3 million lb. for August 1943.

OTHER

Other Frozen stocks amounted to 15,344,158 lb. Frozen Fresh and 76,134 lb. Frozen Smoked, (not including fillets).

All other fish reported as having been frozen during August were 2,671,130 lb.
