

COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS OF FISH, OCTOBER 1, 1945

ALL FISH

Stocks of all frozen fish in Canada on October 1, amounted to 39,388,545 lb. of which 37.5 million lb. were Frozen Fresh and 1.9 million lb. Frozen Smoked. In these figures estimates of 1.7 million lb. Frozen Fresh and 49 thousand lb. Frozen Smoked are included for firms failing to report on time. These holdings are less by 5.1 million lb. Frozen Fresh and 364 thousand lb. Frozen Smoked than those at October 1, 1944. Compared with September 1, 1945 figures they are greater by 3.7 million lb. frozen fresh but are less by 14.4 per cent Frozen Smoked.

The apparent net "Into Storage" movement for all classifications was 3.3 million lb. as compared with a similar movement of 4.0 million lb. during September 1944.

COD

Holdings of Frozen Cod were 6,855,180 lb. consisting of 6,828,488 lb. Frozen Fresh and 26,692 lb. Frozen Smoked (fillets not included).

The apparent net increase during September was 777 thousand lb. as compared with a similar movement of 663 thousand lb. in September 1944.

The quantity reported as frozen during September was 3,545,566 lb. as compared with 2,738,062 lb. for the same month in 1944, but no estimate is made of freezings for firms failing to report.

HADDOCK

Stocks of Frozen Haddock totalled 568,034 lb., of which 550,447 lb. were Frozen Fresh and 17,587 lb. Frozen Smoked (not including fillets). Haddock holdings were 409 thousand lb. less than at the same date last year and 102 thousand lb. more than the stocks on September 1 of this year.

There were 338,011 lb. reported as having been frozen during September while for the corresponding month in 1944 the freezings were 233,708 lb.

FILLETS

Frozen smoked fillets of Cod, Haddock and other fish amounted to 765,726 lb. as compared with 1,078,279 lb. last year and 1,007,990 lb. last month.

There were 379,416 lb. reported as frozen during September of this year.

SALMON

Frozen Salmon holdings at October 1 were 8,913,505 lb. They were 1.3 million lb. more than last year and 51.7 per cent more than last month.

The apparent net increase during September 1945 was 3.0 million lb. as compared with a similar movement of 3.2 million lb. during the same month in 1944.

Freezings during September were 4,014,040 lb. without estimating for late firms.

SEA HERRING

Frozen stocks of herring, including Kippers, were 9,738,585 lb. being Fresh 8,774,097 lb., and Smoked 964,488 lb. Last year at the same date the combined figures were 10,443,123 lb. This month's stocks show an increase of 382 thousand lb. over last month's holdings.

The quantity reported as frozen during September was 3.5 million lb. as compared with freezings of 1.3 million lb. for September 1944. Some firms, however, have not yet reported.

OTHER

Other Frozen stocks amounted to 11,982,121 lb. Frozen Fresh and 109,394 lb. Frozen Smoked, (not including fillets).

All other fish reported as having been frozen during September were 3.4 million lb. but some firms had not reported on time and no estimate is made of freezings.
