#### COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS OF FISH, DECEMBER 1, 1945

ALL FISH

Stocks of all frozen fish in Canada on December 1 amounted to 35,093,361 lb. of which 33.6 million lb. were Frozen Fresh and 1.5 million lb. Frozen Smoked. In these figures estimates of 7.9 million lb. Frozen Fresh and 163 thousand lb. Frozen Smoked are included for firms failing to report on time. These holdings are less by 3.3 million lb. Frozen Fresh and 358 thousand lb. Frozen Smoked than those at December 1, 1944. Compared with November 1, 1945 figures they are less by 4.8 million lb. Frozen Fresh and 341 thousand lb. Frozen Smoked.

The apparent net "Out-of Storage" movement for all classifications was 5.1 million 1b. as compared with a similar movement of 5.7 million 1b. during November 1944.

COD

Holdings of Frozen Cod were 5,609,536 lb. consisting of 5,602,399 lb. Frozen Fresh and 7,137 lb. Frozen Smoked (fillets not included).

The apparent net decrease during November was 890 thousand 1b. as compared with an opposite movement of 1.4 million 1b. in November 1944.

The quantity reported as frozen during November was 1,971,209 lb. as compared with 1,430,336 lb. for the same month in 1944 but no estimate is made of freezings for firms failing to report

HADDOCK
Stocks of Frozen Haddock totalled 482,761 lb., of which 407,030 lb.
were Frozen Fresh and 75,731 lb. Frozen Smoked (not including fillets). Haddock holdings were 487 thousand lb. less than at the same date last year and 135 thousand lb. more than the stocks on November 1 of this year.

There were 337,593 lb. reported as having been frozen during November while for the corresponding month in 1944 the freezings were 299,391 lb.

FILLETS

Frozen smoked fillets of Cod, Haddock and other fish amounted to 768,432 lb. as compared with 898,204 lb. last year and 919,077 lb.

last month.

There were 826,420 lb. reported as frozen during November of

this year.

SALMON Frozen Salmon holdings at December 1 were 10,894,513 lb. They were 2.4 million lb. more than last year and 9.1 per cent less than last month.

The apparent net decrease during November 1945 was 1.1 million 1b. as compared with a similar movement of 1.0 million 1b. during the same month in 1944.

Freezings during November were 591,377 lb. without estimating for late firms.

SEA HERRING

Frozen stocks of herring including Kippers, were 5,138,108 lb.
being Fresh 4,654,872 lb., and Smoked 483,236 lb. Last year at
the same date the combined figures were 7,351,888 lb. This month stocks show a
decrease of 2.6 million lb. from last month's holdings.

The quantity reported as frozen during November was 466 thousand lb. as compared with freezings of 641 thousand lb. for November 1944. Some firms, however, have not yet reported.

OTHER

Other Frozen stocks amounted to 11,555,689 lb. Frozen Fresh and 88,781 lb. Frozen Smoked, (not including fillets).

All other fish reported as having been frozen during November were 1.1 million 1b. but some firms had not reported on time and no estimate is made of freezings.
