COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS OF FISH, FEBRUARY 1, 1945

ALL FISH

Stocks of all frozen fish in Canada on February 1, amounted to 21,258,308

lb., of which 19.8 million lb. were Frozen fresh and 1.5 million lb.

Frozen Smoked. In these figures estimates of 4 million lb. Frozen Fresh and 145 thousand lb.

Frozen Smoked are included for firms failing to report on time. These holdings are less by 7 million lb. Frozen Fresh and 123 thousand lb. Frozen Smoked than those at February 1, 1944.

Compared with January 1, 1945 figures they are lower by 29.3 per cent Frozen Fresh and 24.4 per cent Frozen Smoked.

The apparent net "Out of Storage" movement for all classifications was 8.8 million lb. as compared with a similar movement of 3.5 million lb. during January 1944.

COD Holdings of Frozen Cod were 3,298 431 lb. consisting of 3,280,127 lb. Frozen Fresh and 18,304 lb. Frozen Smoked (fillets not included).

The apparent net decrease during January was 2.3 million lb. as compared with a similar movement of 592 thousand lb. in January 1944.

The quantity reported as frozen during January was 676,809 lb., as compared with 1,422,613 lb. for the same month in 1944, but no estimate is made of freezings for firms failing to report.

HADDOCK
Stocks of frozen Haddock totalled 410,775 lb. of which 286,083 lb.
were Frozen Fresh and 124,692 lb. Frozen Smoked (not including fillets).
Haddock holdings were 653 thousand lb. less than at the same date last year and 299 thousand
Ress than the stocks on January 1, of this year.

There were 293.811 lb, reported as having been frozen during January while for the corresponding month in 1944 the freezings were 224.798 lb.

FILLETS Frozen smoked fillets of Cod, Haddock and other fish amounted to 676,214 lb, as compared with 538,819 lb, last year and 888,603 lb, last month.

There were 515,796 lb. reported as frozen during January of this year.

SALMON Frozen Salmon holdings at February 1 were 4.018,679 lb. They were 2.2 million lb. less than last year and 31.2 per cent less than last month.

The apparent net decrease during January 1944 was 2. Omillion 1b. as compared with a similar movement of 1.8 million 1b. during the same month in 1945.

Freezings during January were 33,321 lb. without estimating for late

Frozen stocks of herring, including Kippers, were 5,829,413 lb. being Fresh 5,217,368 lb. and Smoked 612,045 lb. Last year at the same date the combined figures were 6,203,755 lb. This month's stocks show a decrease of 26 thousand lb. from last month's holdings.

The quantity reported as frozen during January was 672 thousand 1b. as compared with freezings of 1.5 million 1b. for January 1944.

OTHER Other Frozen stocks amounted to 6 945,255 lb, Frozen Fresh and 79,541 lb, Frozen Smoked, (not including fillets).

All other fish reported as having been frozen during December were 1,105,751 lb. but some firms had not reported on time and no estimate is made of freezings.
