

COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS OF FISH, APRIL 1, 1945

ALL FISH

Stocks of all frezen fish in Canada on April 1, amounted to 17,293,958 lb.

of which 16 million lb, were Frozen Fresh and 1,2 million lb. Frozen

Smoked. In these figures estimates of 7 7 million lb. Frozen Fresh and 315 thousand lb.

Frozen Smoked are included for firms failing to report on time. These holdings are less
by 2,9 million lb. Frozen Fresh and 101 thousand lb. Frozen Smoked than those at April 1,
1944. Compared with March 1, 1945 figures they are lower by 17,1 per cent Frozen Fresh
and 5,9 per cent Frozen Smoked.

The apparent net "Out of Storage" movement for all classifications was 3.4 million 1b. as compared with a similar movement of 2.3 million 1b. during March 1944.

COD

Holdings of Frozen Cod ware 2,288.155 lb. consisting of 2,271,113 lb. Frozen Fresh and 17,042 lb. Frozen Smoked (fillets not included).

The apparent net decrease during March was 172 thousand lb. as compared with a similar movement of 351 thousand lb. in March 1944.

The quantity reported as frozen during March was 2,183,079 lb. as compared with 1,720,854 lb. for the same month in 1944, but no estimate is made of freezings for firms failing to report.

HADDOCK Stocks of frozen Haddock totalled 549.162 lb., of which 468,003 lb.

were Frozen Fresh and 81 159 lb. Frozen Smoked (not including fillets).

Haddock holdings were 448 thousand lb. less than at the same date last year and 217 thousand lb. less than the stocks on March 1 of this year.

There were 917,898 lb. reported as having been frozen during March while for the corresponding month in 1944 the freezings were 793,225 lb.

FILLETS

Frozen smoked fillets of Cod Haddock and other fish amounted to 523,991 lb. as compared with 499,730 lb. last year and 646,489 lb. last month.

There were 356,660 lb. reported as frozen during March of this year.

SALMON

Prozen Salmon holdings at April 1 were 2,041,623 lb. They were 540 thousand lb, less than last year and 32,8 per cent less than last month.

The apparent net decrease during March 1944 was 1.5 million 1b. as compared with a similar movement of 1.0 million 1b. during the same month in 1945.

Freezings during March were 28,412 lb, without estimating for late firms.

Fresh 6,778,640 lb, and Smoked 335,545 lb. Last year at the same date the combined figures were 4,078,024 lb. This month's stocks show a decrease of 997 thousand lb. from last month's holdings.

The quantity reported as frozen during March was 85 thousand 1b. as compared with freezings of 849 thousand 1b. for March 1944. Some firms, however, have not yet reported.

OTHER

Other Frozen stocks amounted to 4,502,295 lb. Frozen Fresh and 274,544 lb. Frozen Smoked, (not including fillets).

All other fish reported as having been frozen during March were 410,357 lb. but some firms had not reported on time and no estimate is made of freezings.
