COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS OF FISH, MAY 1, 1945

ALL FISH Stocks of all frozen fish in Canada on May 1, amounted to 15,580,848 lb. of which 14.5 million lb. were Frozen Fresh and 1.1 million lb. Frozen Smoked. In these figures an estimate of 983 thousand lb. Frozen Fresh is included for firms failing to report on time. These holdings are less by 3.2 million lb. Frozen Fresh and 310 thousand lb. Frozen Smoked than those at May 1, 1944. Compared with April 1, 1945 figures they are lower by 5.6 per cent Frozen Fresh and 11.3 per cent Frozen Smoked.

The apparent net "Out-of-Storage" movement for all classifications was 1.0 million lb. as compared with a similar movement of 1.1 million lb. during April 1944.

COD Holdings of Frozen Cod were 2,516,460 lb. consisting of 2,497,618 lb. Frozen Fresh and 18,842 lb. Frozen Smoked (fillets not included).

The apparent net increase during April was 182 thousand lb. as compared with a similar movement of 949 thousand lb. in April 1944.

The quantity reported as frozen during April was 2,995,860 lb. as compared with 2,497,686 lb. for the same month in 1944, but no estimate is made of freezings for firms failing to report.

HADDOCK Stocks of frozen Haddock totalled 795,654 lb. of which 745,801 lb. were frozen fresh and 49,853 lb. Frozen Smoked (not including fillets). Haddock holdings were 187 thousand lb. less than at the same date last year and 139 thousand lb. more than the stocks on April 1 of this year.

There were 640,876 lb. reported as having been frozen during April while for the corresponding month in 1944 the freezings were 440,108 lb.

FILLETS Frozen smoked fillets of Cod, Haddock and other fish amounted to 830,464 lb. as compared with 823,454 lb. last year and 599,308 lb. last month.

There were 959,222 lb. reported as frozen during April of this year.

SALMON Frozen Salmon holdings at May 1 were 1,216,311 lb. They were 530 thousand lb. less than last year and 36 per cent less than last month.

The apparent net decrease during April 1944 was 834 thousand lb. as compared with a similar movement of 688 thousand lb. during the same month in 1945.

Freezings during April were 19,945 lb. without estimating for late firms.

SEA HERRING Frozen stocks of herring, including Kippers, were 6,737,127 lb., being Fresh 6,541,490 lb. and Smoked 195,637 lb. Last year at the same date the combined figures were 2,720,856 lb. This month's stocks show a decrease of 175 thousand lb. from last month's holdings.

The quantity reported as frozen during April was 403 thousand lb. as compared with freezings of 492 thousand lb. for April 1944. Some firms, however, have not yet reported.

OTHER Other Frozen stocks amounted to 3,447,163 lb. Frozen Fresh and 37,669 lb. Frozen Smoked, (not including fillets).

All other fish reported as having been frozen during April were 1,155,990 lb., but some firms had not reported on time and no estimate is made of freezings.
