COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS OF FISH, JUNE 1, 1945

ALL FISH

Stocks of all frozen fish in Canada on June 1, amounted to 20,210,140 lb, of which 19,2 million lb, were Frozen Fresh and 1.0 million lb. Frozen Smoked. In these figures estimates of 7,2 million lb, Frozen Fresh and 130 thousand lb, Frozen Smoked are included for firms failing to report on time. These holdings are less by 481 thousand lb, Frozen Fresh and 827 thousand lb. Frozen Smoked than those at June 1, 1944. Compared with May 1, 1945 figures they are greater by 32,1 per cent Frozen Fresh and less by 11,7 per cent Frozen Smoked.

The apparent net "Into-Storage" movement for all classifications was 4.5 million 1b. as compared with a similar movement of 6.9 million 1b. during May 1944.

COD

Holdings of Frozen Cod were 3,349,705 lb. consisting of 3,328,255 lb. Frozen Fresh and 21,450 lb. Frozen Smoked (fillets not included).

The apparent net increase during May was 785 thousand lb. as compared with a similar movement of 603 thousand lb. in May 1944.

The quantity reported as frozen during May was 2,197,359 1b. as compared with 3,541,947 lb. for the same month in 1944, but no estimate is made of freezings for firms failing to report.

HADDOCK Stocks of frozen Haddock totalled 429,745 lb., of which 379,331 lb. were Frozen Fresh and 50,414 lb. Frozen Smoked (not including fillets). Haddock holdings were 380 thousand lb. less than at the same date last year and 374 thousand lb. less than the stocks on May 1 of this year.

There were 125,378 lb, reported as having been frozen during May while for the corresponding month in 1944 the freezings were 200,516 lb.

FILLETS

Frozen smoked fillets of Cod, Haddock and other fish amounted to 774,209 lb. as compared with 1,270,362 lb. last year and 833,417 lb. last month.

There were 776,979 lb. reported as frozen during May of this year.

SALMON

Frozen Salmon holdings at June 1 were 564,543 lb. They were 640 thousand 1b. less than last year and 54.3 per cent less than last month.

The apparent net decrease during May 1945 was 670 thousand 1b. as compared with a similar movement of 543 thousand 1b. during the same month in 1944.

Freezings during May were 24,862 lb. without estimating for late firms.

SEA HERRING Frozen stocks of herring, including Kippers were 8,465,294 lb. being Fresh 8,341,799 lb. and Smoked 123,495 lb. Last year at the same date the combined figures were 4,900,381 lb. This month's stocks show an increase of 1.7 million lb. over last month's holdings.

The quantity reported as frozen during May was 2,2 million 1b, as compared with freezings of 3,8 million 1b, for May 1944. Some firms, however, have not yet reported.

OTHER

Other Frozen stocks amounted to 6.568.455 lb. Frozen Fresh and 58,189 lb. Frozen Smoked, (not including fillets).

All other fish reported as having been frozen during May were 3.8 million 1b. but some firms had not reported on time and no estimate is made of freezings.
