COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS OF FISH OCTOBER 1, 1946

ALL FISH Stocks of all frozen fish in Canada on October 1, amounted to 48,063,367 1b. of which 45 million 1b. were Frozen Fresh and 3.2 million 1b. Frozen Smoked. In these figures estimates of 4.4 million 1b. Frozen Fresh and 393 thousand 1b. Frozen Smoked are included for firms failing to report on time. These holdings are higher by 11.8 million 1b. Frozen Fresh and 1.2 million 1b. Frozen Smoked than those at October 1, 1945. Compared with September 1, 1946 figures they are less by 523 thousand 1b. Frozen Fresh and 67 thousand Frozen Smoked.

The apparent net "out-of-storage" movement for all classifications was 590 thousand 1b. as compared with an opposite movement of 2.4 million 1b. during September

Holdings of Frozen God were 11,690,096 1b. consisting of 11,643, 326 1b. COD Frozen Fresh and 46.770 lb. Prozen Smoked (Fillets not included).

> The apparent net decrease during September was 1.4 million as compared with an opposite movement of 584 thousand lb. in September 1945.

The quantity reported as frozen during September was 3,441,788 lb. as compared with 4,022,717 lb. for the same month in 1945 but no estimate is made for freezings for firms failing to report.

Stocks of Frozen Haddock totalled 758,679 lb. of which 595,458 lb. were Frozen HADDOCK Fresh and 163,221 lb. Frozen Smoked (not including fillets) Haddock holdings were 242,580 lb. higher than at the same date last year and 167,124 lb. less than the stocks on September 1 of this year.

> There were 336,946 lb. reported as having been frozen during September while for the corresponding month in 1945 freezings were 348,281 lb.

Frozen smoked fillets of God, Haddock and other fish amounted to 1,538,495 lb. FILLETS as compared with 761,105 lb. last year and 1,739,552 lb. last month. There were 351,128 lb. reported as frozen during September 1 of this year.

Frozen Salmon holdings at October 1 were 6,999,043 lb, as compared with SALMON 8,926,241 last year, and 4,357,788 lb. last month.

> The apparent net incresse during September was 2.6 million 10. as compared with a similar movement of 3.0 million 1b. during the same month in 1945.

> Freezings during September were 3,673,078 lb. without estimating for late firms.

SEA HERAING Frozen stocks of herring including kippers, were 10,132,380 lb. being Fresh 8,988,029 lb. and smoked, 1,143,751 lb. Last year at the same date the combined figures were 9,898,057 lb. This month's stocks show an increase of 138,337 lb. over last month's holdings.

> The quantity reported as frozen during September was 1,091,255 1b. as compared with freezings of 3,949,003 lb. for September 1945. Some firms, however, have not yet reported.

Other frozen stocks amounted to 16,944,674 lb. ceing Frozen Fresh, 16,703,318 1b. and Frozen Smoked (not including fillets) 241,356 lb.

> All other fish reported as having been frozen during September were 1,899,430 1b. but some firms had not reported on time and no estimate is made of freezings.
