COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS OF FIGH NOVELLER 1, 1946

ALL FISH

Stocks of all frozen fish in Canada on November 1 amounted to 47,598,135 lb. of which 44.8 million lb. were Frozen Fresh and 2.8 million lb. Frozen Smoked. In these figures estimates of 10.9 million lb. Frozen Fresh and 430 thousand lb. Frozen Smoked are included for firms failing to report on time. These holdings are higher by 5.9 million lb. Frozen Fresh and 975 thousand lb. Frozen Smoked than those at November 1, 1945. Compared with October 1, 1946 figures they are less by 173 thousand lb. Frozen Fresh and 232 thousand Frozen Smoked.

The apparent net "out of storage" movement for all classifications was 405 thousand 1b. as compared with an opposite movement of 667 thousand 1b. during October 1945.

COD Holdings of Frozen Cod were 10,138,453 lb. consisting of 10,104,746 lb. Frozen Fresh and 35,707 lb. Frozen Smoked. (Fillets not included)

The apparent net decrease during October was 1.7 million as compared with a similar movement of 749 thousand 1b. in October 1945.

The quantity reported as frozen during October was 2,769,036 lb. as compared with 3,850,166 lb. for the same month in 1945 but no estimate is made for freezings for firms failing to report.

HADDOCK Stocks of Frozen Haddock totalled 718,317 lb. of which 606,196 lb. were Frozen Fresh and 112,121 lb. Frozen Smoked (not including fillets) Haddock holdings were 370,274 lb. higher than at the same date last year and 63,788 lb. less than the stocks on October 1 of this year.

There were 320,372 lb. reported as naving been frozen during October while for the corresponding month in 1945 freezings were 110,837 lb.

FILLETS

Frozen Smoked fillets of Cod, Haddock and Other fish amounted to 1,592,572 lb. as compared with 919,077 lb. last year and 1,484,727 lb. last month. There were 725,186 lb. reported as frozen during October 1, of this year.

SALMON

Frozen Salmon holdings at November 1 were 11,410,733 lb. as compared with 12,305,637 lb. last year and 6,940,315 lb. last month.

The apparent net increase during October was 4.5 million 1b. as compared with a similar movement of 3.4 million 1b. during the same month in 1945.

Freezings during October were 4,632,970 lb. without estimating for late firms.

SEA HERRING

Frozen stocks of herring including kippers, were 6,959,330 lb. being Fresh, 6,248,564 lb. and Smoked, 710,766 lb. Last year at the same date the combined figures were 7,731,578 lb. This month's stocks show a decrease of 3,092,185 lb. from last month's holdings.

The quantity reported as frozen during October was 762,291 lb. as compared with freezings of 672,158 lb. for October 1945. Some firms, however, have not yet reported.

Other

Other frozen stocks amounted to 16,778,728 lb. being Frozen Fresh, 16,588,032 lb. and Frozen Smoked (not including fillets) 190,696 lb.

All other fish reported as having been frozen during October were 2,639,777 lb. but some firms had not reported on time and no estimate is made of their freezings.
