COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS OF FISH APRIL 1. 1946

ALL FISH

Stocks of all frozen fish in Canada on April 1 amounted to 18,437,184 1b. of which 17.1 million lb. were Frozen Fresh and 1.3 million lb. Frozen Smoked. In these figures estimates of 330 thousand lb. Frozen Fresh and 65 thousand lb. Frozen Smoked are included for firms failing to report on time. These holdings are higher by 1.7 million lb. Frozen Fresh and 23 thousand lb. Frozen Smoked than those at April 1, 1945. Compared with March 1, 1946 figures they are higher by 360 thousand lb. Frozen Fresh and by 190 thousand lb. Frozen Smoked.

The apparent net "Into-Storage" movement for all classifications was 550 thousand lb. as compared with an opposite movement of 4.2 million lb. during March 1945.

COD Holdings of Frozen Cod were 2,889,628 lb. consisting of 2,881,523 lb. Frozen Fresh and 8,105 lb. Frozen Smoked (fillets not included).

The apparent net increase during March was 780 thousand lb. as compared with an opposite movement of 176 thousand lb. in March 1945.

The quantity reported as frozen during March was 1,822,630 lb. as compared with 3,007,526 lb. for the same month in 1945, but no estimate is made of freezings for firms failing to report.

Stocks of Frozen Haddock totalled 576,685 lb., of which 532,450 lb. were Frozen Fresh and 44,235 lb. Frozen Smoked (not including fillets). Haddock holdings were 88,683 lb. less than at the same date last year and 77,810 lb. more than the stocks on March 1 of this year.

There were 502,896 lb. reported as having been frozen during March while for the corresponding month in 1945 freezings were 1,378,118 lb.

FILLETS

Frozen smoked fillets of Cod, Haddock and other fish amounted to 800,921 lb. as compared with 599,552 lb. last year and 452,754 lb. last month. There were 893,360 lb. reported as frozen during March of this year.

SALMON Frozen Salmon holdings at April 1 were 2,746,120 lb. They were 814 thousand lb. more than last year and 42.0 per cent less than last month.

The apparent net decrease during March was 2.0 million lb. as compared with a similar movement of 1.2 million lb. during the same month in 1945.

Freezings during March were 24,870 lb. without estimating for late firms.

Frozen stocks of herring including Kippers, were 4,017,203 lb. being Fresh 3,643,277 lb. and Smoked 373,926 lb. Last year at the same date the combined figures were 6,938,695 lb. This month's stocks show an increase of 155,024 lb. from last month's holdings.

The quantity reported as forzen during March was 220,126 lb, as compared with freezings of 480,077 lb. for March 1945. Some firms however have not yet reported.

OTHER Other Frozen stocks amounted to 7,375,481 lb. Frozen Fresh and 31,146 lb. Frozen Smoked, (not including fillets).

All other fish reported as having been frozen during March were 433,248 lb. but some firms had not reported on time and no estimate is made of freezings.
