COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS OF FISH JULY 1, 1946

ALL FISH

Stocks of all frozen fish in Canada on July 1 amounted to 33,437,531 lb. of which 31.6 million lb. were Frozen Fresh and 1.8 million lb. Frozen Smoked. In these figures estimates of 1.9 million lb. Frozen Fresh and 70 thousand lb. Frozen Smoked are included for firms failing to report on time. These heldings are higher by 7.2 million lb. Frozen Fresh and 433 thousand lb. Frozen Smoked than those at July 1, 1945. Compared with June 1, 1946 figures they are higher by 9.3 million lb. Frozen Fresh and by 113 thousand lb. Frozen Smoked.

The apparent net "into storage" movement for all calssifications was 9.4 million 1b. as compared with a similar movement of 7.1 million 1b. during June 1945.

Heldings of Frezen God were 9,894,910 lb. consisting of 9,888,290 lb Frezen Fresh and 6,620 lb. Frezen Smoked (Fillets not included)

The apparent net increase during June was 4.3 million as compared with a similar movement of 3.0 million 1b. in June 1945.

The quantity reported as frozen during June was 7,117,936 lb. as compared with 7,129,580 lb. for the same month in 1945 but no estimate is made for freezings for firms failing to report.

HADDOCK Stocks of Frozen Haddock totalled 464,220 lb. of which 353,023 lb. were Frozen Fresh and Ill,197 lb. Frozen Emoked (not including fillets) Haddock holdings were 70,180 lb. less than at the same date last year and 94,838 lb. mere than the stocks on June 1 of this year.

There were 381,440 lb. reported as having been frozen during June while for the corresponding month in 1945 freezings were 1,120,210 lb.

FILLETS Frozen smoked fillets of Cod, Haddock and other fish amounted to 1,444,887 lb. as compared with 1,065,661 lb. last year and 1,247,643 lb. last month There were 1,098,502 lb. reported as frozen during June of this year.

SALMON Frozen Salmon holdings at July 1 were 1,671,434 lb. They were 683 thousand lb. more than last year and 124.8 per cent more than last month.

The apparent net increase during June was 928 thousand 1b. as compared with a similar movement of 323 thousand 1b. during the same menth in 1945.

Freezings during June were 1,193,057 lb. without estimating for late

Fresh 2,885,655 lb. and Smoked 217,215 lb. Last year at the same date the combined figures were 5,331,619 lb. This month's stocks show a decrease of 2,036,661 lb. from last month's holdings.

The quantity reported as frozen during June was 234,404 lb. as compared with freezings of 273,357 lb. for June 1945. Some firms however have not yet reported.

OTHER Other frozen stocks amounted to 16,620,900 lb. Frozen Fresh and 64,010 lb. Frozen Smoked (net including fillets)

All other fish reported as having been frozen during June were 6,609,804 lb. but some firms had not reported on time and no estimate is made of freezings.
