COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS OF FISH AUGUST 1, 1946

ALL FISH

Stocks of all frozen fish in Canada on August 1, amounted to 42,564,850 lb. of which 39.3 million lb. were Frozen Fresh and 3.3 million lb. Frozen Smoked. In these figures estimates of 3.5 million lb. Frozen Fresh and 605 thousand lb. Frozen Smoked are included for firms failing to report on time. These holdings are higher by 7.8 million lb. Frozen Fresh and 1.3 million lb. Frozen Smoked than those at August 1, 1945. Compared with July 1, 1946 figures they are higher by 7.2 million lb. Frozen Fresh and 1.4 million lb. Frozen Smoked.

The apparent net "into-storage" movement for all classifications was 8.6 million lb. as compared with a similar movement 7.7 million lb. during July 1945.

COD

Holdings of Frozen Cod were 11.330,795 lb. consisting of 11,319,540 lb. Frozen Fresh and 11.255 lb. Frozen Smoked (Fillets not included)

The apparent net increase during July was 1.3 million as compared with a similar movement of 1.7 million 1b. in July 1945.

The quantity reported as frozen during July was 7,293,706 lb. as compared with 12.491,569 lb. for the same month in 1945 but ne estimate is made for freezings for firms failing to report.

HADDOCK

Stocks of Frozen Haddock totalled 728,549 lb. of which 591,597 lb. were Frozen Fresh and 126,952 lb. Frozen Smoked (not including fillets) Haddock holdings were 119.319 lb. higher than at the same date last year and 246.424 lb. more than the stocks on July 1 of this year.

There were 437,093 lb. reported as having been free en during July while for the corresponding month in 1945 freezings were 345.175 lb.

FILLETS

Frozen smoked fillets of Cod, Haddock and other fish amounted to 2,009,654 lb. as compared with 1,121,506 lb. last year and 1,489,487 lb. last month. There were 643.012 lb. reported as frozen during July of this year.

SALMON

Frozen Salmon holdings at August 1 were 2,485,716 lb. They were 146 thousand lb. more than last year and 66.5 per cent more than last month.

The apparent net increase during July was 993 thousand 1b. as compared with a similar movement of 1.7 million 1b. during the same month in 1945.

Freezings during July were 2,136,781 lb. without estimating for late firms.

SEA HERRING Frozen stocks of herring including Kippers, were 7,185,422 lb. being Fresh 6,451,966 lb. and Smoked 733,456 lb. Last year at the same date the combined figures were 8,406,628 lb. This month's stocks show an increase of 4,155,368 lb. ever last month's holdings.

The quantity reported as frozen during July was 3,520,214 lb. as compared with freezings of 5,226,633 lb. for July 1945. Some firms however have not yet reported.

OTHER

Other frozen stocks amounted to 18,213,489 lb. Frozen Fresh and 288,255 lb. Frozen Smoked (not including fillets).

All other fish reported as having been frozen during July were 3,606,840 lb. but some firms had not reported on time and no estimate is made of freezings.
