COLD ETOFAGF HOLDINGS OF FISH OCTOBER 1,1947
ALL FISH
Stocks of all frozen fish in Canade on October 1 amounted to 47,278,720 Lb. of which 43.3 million 1 b , were Frozen Fresh and 4.0 million 1 b . Frozen Snaked. In these figures estinetes of 3.8 million $1 b$. Frozen Fresh and 596 thousend lb. Frozen Smoked are included for firms failing to report on time. These holdings are lower by 1.8 million lb. Frozen Fresh and higher by 933 thousand 1b. Frozen Smoked than those at October 1, 1946. Conpared with September 1, 1947 figures they are. lower by 1.9 willion 1b. Frozen Fresh and by 781 thousand lb. Frozen Snaked.

The apparent net "out-of-Storage" movement for all classifications was 2.7 million 1 b . as compared with a similar movement of 876 thousand 1 b . during September 1946.

COD Holdings of frozen cod were 5,259,184 1b consisting of 5,237,837 1 b .
Frozen Fresh and 21,347 1b. Frozen Smoked. (Fillets not included)
The epperent net decrease during September was 616 thousund 1 b . as compared with a like movement of lak million lb. in Septenber 1946.

The quantity reported as frozen during September was 925,241 lb. \&s compred with $3,604,345$. for the same month in 1946 but no estinate is made for freezings for firms failing to report.

HADDOCK Stocks of frozen Heddock totalled 2,038,761 1b. of which 1,615,573 1b. were Frozen Fresh and $423,188 \mathrm{lb}$. Frowen Smoked (not including Fillets) Haddock holdings were $1,256,656$ 1b. more than at the same date last year and 264,771 1b. less then the stocks on hand last month.

There were 352,293 lb. reported as having been frozen during September While for the corresponding month in 1946 freezings were 350,717 Ib.

FILLETG Frozen Smoked fillats of Cod, Haddock and Other Fish mounted to $1,762,053 \mathrm{lb}$. as compared with $1,486,857 \mathrm{lb}$. last year and 2,403,440 1b. last month. There were 242,697 lb. reported es frozen during September 1947

SALMON Frozen Salmon holdings at October 1, were 6,439,568 lb. as compared with 6,948,442 1b. last yewr and $5,097,345 \mathrm{lb}$, last month.

The apparent net incresse during september was 1.3 miliion 1 b . as compared with similar movement of 2.6 million lb. during the same month in 1946.

Freezings during September were 2,660,370 1b. without estinating for late firms.

CEA HFRRING Frozen stocks of herring including kippers, were 12,258,657 1b. being Fresh $10,868,4061 \mathrm{~b}$. and $\mathrm{S}_{\text {moked }} 1,390,251$ 1b. Last year at the same date the conbined figures here $10,052,805 \mathrm{lb}$. This month's stocks show decrease of 231,377 1b. from last month's holdings.

The quantity reported as frozen during September was $1,807,836 \mathrm{lb}$. as compred with freezings of $2,286,367 \mathrm{lb}$. for september 1946 . Sone firms, however, have
not yet reported.
$\frac{\text { OTHFR }}{19,462,191} 1 \mathrm{~b}$. Other frazen atocks mounted to $19,520,497$ 1b. being Frozen Fresh $19,462,191$ 1b. and Frozen $S_{m o k e d ~(n o t ~ i n c l u d i n g ~ f i l l e t s) ~ 60,306 ~ 1 b . ~}^{\text {m }}$.

A11 other fish reported as having been frozen during September fere 1,522,534 lb. but some firms had not yet reported end no estimete is made of their freezings.
