#### COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS OF FISH NOVEMBER 1, 1947

ALL FISH Stocks of all frozen fish in Canada on November 1 amounted to 48,640,353 lb. of which 44,946,300 lb. were Frozen Fresh and 3.7 million lb. Frozen Smoked. In these figures estimates of 5.2 million lb. Frozen Fresh and 420 thousand lb. Frozen Smoked are included for firms failing to report on time. These holdings are higher by 572 thousand lb. Frozen Fresh and higher by 962 thousand lb. Frozen Smoked than those at November 1 1946. Compared with October 1, 1947 figures they are higher by 1.3 million lb. Frozen Fresh and lower by 120 thousand lb. Frozen Smoked.

There was an "into-storage" movement for all classifications of 1.1 million lb. as compared with an opposite movement of 1.0 million lb. during October 1946.

COD Holdings of frozen cod were 4,771,081 lb. consisting of 4,751,731 lb. Frozen Fresh and 19,350 lb. Frozen Smoked. (Fillets not included)

The apparent net decrease during October was 663 thousand 1b. as compared with a like movement of 1.5 million 1b. in October 1946.

The quantity reported as frozen during October was 1,432,997 lb. as compared with 3,467,951 lb. for the same month in 1946 but no estimate is made for freezings for firms failing to report.

HADDOCK Stocks of frozen Haddock totalled 1,660,044 lb. of which 1,224,207 lb. were Frozen Fresh and 435,837 lb. Frozen Smoked (not including Fillets) Haddock holdings were 929,243 lb. more than at the same date last year and 322,716 lb. less than the stocks on hand last month.

There were 575,669 lb. reported as having been frozen during October while for the corresponding month in 1946 freezings were 326,112 lb.

FILLETS Frozen Smoked fillets of Cod, Haddock and Other Fish amounted to 1,743.48% lb. as compared with 1,647,007 lb. last year and 1,702,023 lb. last month There were 791,681 lb. reported as frozen during October 1947.

SALMON Frozen Salmon holdings at November 1 were 10,967,145 lb. as compared with 10,524,957 lb. last year and 6,362,525 lb. last month.

The apparent net increase during October was 4.6 million 1b. as compared with a similar movement of 3.6 million 1b. during the same month in 1946.

Freezings during October were 4,810,593 lb. without estimating for late firms.

SEA HERRING Frozen stocks of herring including kippers, were 10,447,597 lb. being Fresh 9,379,064 lb. and Smoked 1,068,533 lb. Last year at the same date the combined figures were 6,921,420 lb. This month's stocks show a decrease of 1,609,889 lb. from last month's holdings.

The quantity reported as frozen during October was 350,911 lb. as compared with freezings of 831,013 lb. for October 1946. Some firms, however, have not yet reported.

Other frozen stocks smounted to 19,051,002 lb. being Frozen Fresh 18,972,481 lb. and Frozen Smoked (not including fillets) 78,521 lb.

All other fish reported as having been frozen during October were 3,343,378 lb. but some firms had not yet reported and no estimate is made of their freezings.
