

COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS OF FISH MAY 1, 1947

ALL FISH

Stocks of all frozen fish in Canada on May 1 amounted to 22,769,119 1b.
of which 21.0 million 1b. were Frozen Fresh and 1.8 million 1b. Frozen Smoked. In
these figures estimates of 760 thousand 1b. Frozen Fresh and 200 thousand 1b. Frozen
Smoked are included for firms failing to report on time. These holdings are higher
by 5.4 million 1b. Frozen Fresh and 364 thousand 1b. Frozen smoked than those at
May 1, 1946. Compared with April 1, 1947 figures they are less by 3.3 million 1b.
Frozen Fresh and higher by 354 thousand 1b. Frozen smoked.

The apparent net "Out-of- Storage" movement for all classifications was 3.0 million 1b. as compared with a similar movement of 1.8 million 1b. during April 1946.

COD Holdings of Frozen God were 4,512,828 lb. consisting of 4,474,753 lb. Frozen Fresh and 38,075 lb. Frozen Smoked. (Fillets not included).

The apparent net decrease during April was 519 thousand 1b. as compared with an opposite movement of 505 thousand 1b. in April 1946.

The quantity reported as frozen during April was 619,971 lb. as compared with 2,160,749 lb. for the same month in 1946 but no estimate is made for freezings for firms failing to report.

HADDOCK Stocks of Frozen Haddock totalled 695,146 lb. of which 533,180 lb. were Frozen Fresh and 161,966 lb. Frozen Smoked (not including Fillets). Haddock holdings were 255,181 lb. higher than at the same date last year and 373,903 lb. higher than the stocks on hand last month.

There were 489,160 lb. reported as having been frozen during April while for the corresponding month in 1946 freezings were 459,952 lb.

FILLETS Frozen Smoked fillets of God, Haddock and Other Fish amounted to 1,145,297 lb. as compared with 1,043,050 lb. last year and 847,511 lb. last month. There were 898,940 lb. reported as frozen during April 1947.

SALMON Frozen Salmon holdings at May 1, were 3,088,683 lb. as compared with 1,497,273 lb. last year and 4,259,653 lb. last month.

The apparent net decrease during April was 1.2 million 1b. as compared with a similar movement of 1.4 million 1b. during the same month in 1946.

Freezings during April were 41,620 lb. without estimating for late firms.

Fresh 6,076,357 lb. and Smoked 375,985 lb. Last year at the same date the combined figures were 3,178,052 lb. This month's stocks show a decrease of 863,565 lb. from last month's holdings.

The quantity reported as frozen during April was 289,986 lb. as compared with freezings of 195,975 lb. for April 1946. Some firms, however have not yet reported.

OTHER Other frozen stocks amounted to 6,874,903 lb. being Frozen Fresh 6,809,235 lb. and Frozen Smoked (not including fillets) 65,668 lb.

All other fish reported as having been frozen during April were 1,082,233 lb. but some firms had not yet reported and no estimate is made of their freezings.
