COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS OF FISH - NOVEMBER 1, 1948

ALL FISH Stocks of all frozen fish in Canada amounted to 46,393,218 lb. on November 1, of which 43,540,188 lb. were frozen fresh and 2,853,030 lb. frozen smoked. In these figures estimates of 6,445,000 lb. frozen fresh and 215,000 lb. frozen smoked are included for firms failing to report on time. These holdings are lower by 2.4 million pounds frozen fresh and lower by 869 thousand lb. frozen smoked than those at November 1, 1947. Compared with October 1, 1948 figures they are higher by 3.5 million pounds frozen fresh and lower by 260 thousand pounds frozen smoked. There was an "into-storage" movement for all classifications of 3.3 million lb. as compared with a similar movement of 2.0 million lb. during October 1947.

SEA FISH COD Holdings of frozen cod were 6,334,598 lb. not including estimates consisting of 4,973,900 lb. frozen fresh and 1,360,698 lb. frozen smoked. The apparent net decrease during October was 581 thousand lb. as compared with a similar movement of 568 thousand pounds during October 1947. The quantity reported as having been frozen during October was 2,108,000 lb. but no estimate is made for firms failing to report on time.

HADDOCK Stocks of frozen haddock totalled 1,908,534 lb. not including estimates for late firms, of which 1,519,146 lb. were frozen fresh and 389,388 lb. frozen smoked. Haddock holdings were 143,966 lb. higher than the stocks on hand last year and 184,029 lb. higher than last month. There were 950,434 lb. reported as having been frozen during October.

SALMON Frozen salmon stocks at November 1 were 9,879,391 lb. without estimating for late firms, as compared with 11,354,827 lb. last year and 6,077,200 lb. last month. The apparent net increase during October was 3,802,191 lb. as compared with a similar movement of 4.9 million lb. during the same month in 1947. Freezings during October were 8,385,438 lb.

SEA HERRING Frozen stocks of herring, including kippers reported were 7,651,931 lb. being Fresh 6,956,178 lb. and smoked 695,753 lb. Last year at the same date the combined figures were 10,533,408 lb. This month's figures show a decrease of 3,049,349 lb. under last month's holdings. The quantity frozen during October was 264,545 lb.

OTHER SEA FISH Other frozen stocks amounted to 8,092,740 lb. being reported as frozen fresh 7,967,991 lb. and frozen smoked 124,749 lb. All other sea fish reported as having been frozen during October were 1,014,426 lb.

INLAND FISH There were on hand 5,859,508 lb. of Inland Fish frozen fresh and 6,516 lb. frozen smoked. There were also 3,091,650 lb. of inland fish frozen during October.
