COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS OF FISH - DECEMBER 1, 1948

ALL FISH Stocks of all frozen fish in Canada amounted to 43,375,866 lb. on December 1, of which 40,390,020 lb. were frozen fresh and 2,985,846 lb. frozen smoked. In these figures estimates of 905,000 lb. frozen fresh and 330,000 lb. frozen smoked are included for firms failing to report on time. These holdings are higher by 56 thousand pounds frozen fresh and lower by 749 thousand pounds frozen smoked than those at December 1, 1947. Compared with November 1, 1948 figures they are lower by 3.6 million pounds frozen fresh and higher by 4 thousand pounds frozen smoked. There was an "out-of-storage" movement for all classifications of 3.6 million pounds as compared with a similar movement of 5.6 million lb. during November 1947.

SEA FISH COD Holdings of frozen cod were 7,361,846 lb. not including estimates consisting of 5,947,828 lb. frozen fresh and 1,414,018 lb. frozen smoked. The apparent net increase during November was 583 thousand lb. as compared with an opposite movement of 812 thousand pounds during November 1947. The quantity reported as having been frozen during November was 2,589,335 lb. but no estimate is made for firms failing to report on time.

HADDOCK Stocks of frozen haddock totalled 2,032,866 lb. not including estimates for late firms, of which 1,570,123 lb. were frozen fresh and 462,743 lb. frozen smoked. Haddock holdings were 493,352 lb. higher than the stocks on hand last year and 27,576 pounds higher than last month. There were 831,605 lb. reported as having been frozen during November.

SALMON Frozen salmon stocks at December 1 were 10,341,757 lb. without estimating for late firms, as compared with 11,571,824 lb. last year and 12,540,876 lb. last month. The apparent net decrease during November was 2,199,119 lb. as compared with an opposite movement of 217 thousand lb. during the same month in 1947. Freezings during November were 2,022,557 lb.

SEA HERRING Frozen stocks of herring, including kippers reported were 5,616,224 lb. being Fresh 5,010,253 lb. and smoked 605,971 lb. Last year at the same date the combined figures were 3,014,915 lb. This month's figures show a decrease of 2,126,796 lb. under last month's holdings. The quantity frozen during November was 397,509 lb.

OTHER SEA FISH Other frozen stocks amounted to 10,667,067 lb. being reported as frozen fresh 10,545,299 lb. and frozen smoked 121,768 lb. All other sea fish reported as having been frozen during November were 1,261,013 lb.

INLAND FISH There were on hand 6,111,098 lb. of Inland Fish frozen fresh and 10,008 lb. frozen smoked. There were also 629,603 lb. of inland fish frozen during November.
