## GOLD STORAGE HOLDINGS OF FISH－JULY 1,1948

ALL FISH of which $30,702,995 \mathrm{lb}$ ．were froaen fresh and 4，106，520 lb ．frozen smoked．In these figures estimates of 970 thousand pounds frozen fresh and $570,000 \mathrm{Zb}$ ．frozen smoked are includ ed for firms falling to report on time．These holdings are lower by 1.9 million lb． frozen fresh and higher by 877 thousand $2 b$ ．frozan smoked than those at July $1,1947$. Compared with June 1， 1948 figures they are higher by 3.1 million pound frozen fresh and higher by 447 thousand pounds frozen smoked．There was an＂into－storage＂movement for all classifications of 3.6 million 1 b ．as compared with a similar movement of 6.4 million 1b．auring June 1947．

## SEA FISH

SOD
Holdings of frozen cod were $5,626,250 \mathrm{lb}$ ．not including estinates， consisting of $3,285,209 \mathrm{lb}$ ．frozen fresh and $2,341,041 \mathrm{lb}$ ．fruzen smoked．The apparent net increase during June was $50 \%$ thousend 16 。 as compared with a similar movement of 1.1 million pounds during June 1947．The quantity reported as having been frozen during June was 1，997， 871 pounds，but no estimate is made for firms failing to report on time．
HADDOCK
Stocks of frozen haddock totalled $1,963,501 \mathrm{lb}$ ．not includine estimates for late firms，of which $1,617,570 \mathrm{lb}$ 。 were frozen fiest and $345,931 \mathrm{lb}$ ．frozen smoked． Heddock holdings were $94,968 \mathrm{lb}$ ．lower than the stocks on hand last year and 693，760 16． over last month．There were $1,548,217 \mathrm{lb}$ ．reported as having been frozen during June．

## SALMON

SEA HEFRING Frozen stocks of herring，including kippers，reported were 6，601，939 16． being Fresh，6004，550 lb 。 and smoked $5 \varsigma 7,389 \mathrm{lb}$ ．Last year at the same date the combined fiepures were 6，662，998 lb 。 This month＇s fleures show a decrease of 2.2 million 1 b ．under last month＇s holdings．The quantity frozen during June was 668，761 1 lb ．
$\frac{\text { OTHER SEA FISH }}{\text { fresh } 14,326,174}$ Other frozen stocks amounted to $14,420,840 \mathrm{lb}$ 。being reported as frozen fresh 14，326，174 lb ．and frozen smoked $94,666 \mathrm{lb}$ ．All other sea fish reported as liaving been frozen during $J$ une were $6,668,310 \mathrm{lb}$ ．

INIAND FISH There were on hand $1,848,38 \mathrm{Clb}$ ．Of Inland Fish frozen fresh and 4，077 lb．frozen smoked．There were also $584,493 \mathrm{lb}$ ．of inland fish frozon during June．
