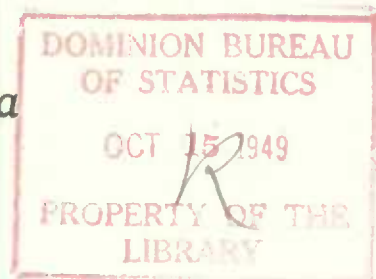

GOLD STORAGE HOLDINGS OF FISH - 1949

ALL FISH

Stocks of all frozen fish in Canada amounted to 47,569,000 lb. on October 1, of which 44,429,000 lb. were frozen fresh, and 3,140,000 lb. frozen smoked. In these figures estimates of 2,300,000 lb. frozen fresh and 325,000 lb. frozen smoked are included for firms failing to report on time. These holdings are higher by 4,329,000 lb. frozen fresh and higher by 27,000 lb. frozen smoked, than those at October 1, 1948. Compared with September 1, 1949 figures they are lower by 1,591,000 lb. frozen fresh and lower by 330,000 lb. frozen smoked. There was an "out-of-storage" movement for all classifications of 1.9 million pounds as compared with an opposite movement of 2.2 million pounds during September 1948.

SEA FISH - COD

Stocks of frozen cod were 6,792,000 lb. not including estimates for late firms, consisting of 5,480,000 lb. frozen fresh and 1,312,000 lb. frozen smoked. The apparent net decrease during September was 286,000 lb. as compared with a similar movement of 628,000 lb. during September 1948. The quantity reported as having been frozen during September was 1,443,000 lb. but no estimate is made for firms failing to report on time.

HADDOCK

Stocks of frozen haddock totalled 908,000 lb. not including estimates for late firms, of which 640,000 lb. were frozen fresh and 268,000 lb. frozen smoked. Haddock holdings were 815,000 lb. lower than the stocks on hand last year, and 360,000 lb. lower than last month. There were 243,000 lb. reported as having been frozen during September 1949.

SALMON

Frozen salmon stocks at October 1, were 9,227,000 lb. without estimating for late firms, as compared with 6,075,000 lb. last year, and 7,247,000 lb. last month. The apparent net increase during September was 1,980,000 lb. as compared with a similar movement of 1,334,000 lb. during the same month in 1948. Freezings during September were 3,923,000 lb.

SEA HERRING

Frozen stocks of herring, including kippers, were reported as being 9,325,000 lb. of which 8,356,000 lb. were fresh, and 969,000 lb. smoked. Last year at the same date the combined figure was 10,703,000 lb. This month's figures show a decrease of 2,011,000 lb. from last month's stocks. The quantity frozen during September was 1,520,000 lb.

OTHER SEA FISH

Other frozen stocks amounted to 14,085,000 lb. being reported as frozen fresh 14,026,000 lb. and frozen smoked 59,000 lb. All other sea fish reported as having been frozen during September was 413,000 lb.

INLAND FISH

There were on hand 4,486,000 lb. of inland fish frozen fresh and 121,000 lb. frozen smoked. There were 1,254,000 lb. of inland fish frozen during September.
