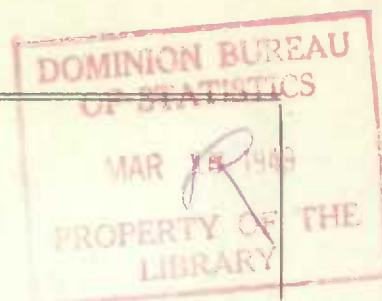

COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS OF FISH -- MARCH 1, 1949

ALL FISH Stocks of all frozen fish in Canada amounted to 28,513,000 lb. on March 1, of which 26.8 million lb. were frozen fresh and 1.7 million lb. frozen smoked. In these figures estimates of 825,000 lb. frozen fresh and 50,000 lb. frozen smoked are included for firms failing to report on time. These holdings are higher by 802,000 lb. frozen fresh and lower by 575,000 lb. frozen smoked, than those at March 1, 1948. Compared with February 1, 1949 figures they are lower by 3.3 million lb. frozen fresh and lower by 362,000 lb. frozen smoked. There was an "out-of-storage" movement for all classifications of 3.7 million lb. as compared with a similar movement of 6.1 million lb. during February 1948.

SEA FISH-COD Holdings of frozen cod were 3,648,000 lb. not including estimates, consisting of 2,783,000 lb. frozen fresh and 865,000 lb. frozen smoked. The apparent net decrease during February was 2.1 million pounds as compared with a similar movement of 1.3 million lb. during February 1948. The quantity reported as having been frozen during February was 913,000 lb. but no estimate is made for firms failing to report on time.

HADDOCK Stocks of frozen haddock totalled 1,198,000 lb. not including estimates for late firms, of which 771,000 lb. were frozen fresh and 427,000 lb. frozen smoked. Haddock holdings were 349,000 lb. higher than the stocks on hand last year and 222,000 lb. lower than last month. There were 768,000 lb. reported as having been frozen during February.

SALMON Frozen salmon stocks at March 1 were 5,556,000 lb. without estimating for late firms, as compared with 9,106,000 lb. last year and 7,811,000 lb. last month. The apparent net decrease during February was 2.3 million lb. as compared with a similar movement of 1.9 million lb. during the same month in 1948. Freezings during February were 27,000 lb.

SEA HERRING Frozen stocks of herring, including kippers reported were 6,382,000 lb. being fresh, 6,146,000 lb. and smoked 236,000 lb. Last year at the same date the combined figures were 7,696,000 lb. This month's figures show an increase of 1.4 million lb. over last month's holdings. The quantity frozen during February was 2,055,000 lb.

OTHER SEA FISH

Other frozen stocks amounted to 5,785,000 lb. being reported as frozen fresh 5,695,000 lb. and frozen smoked 90,000 lb. All other sea fish reported as having been frozen during February were 383,000 lb.

INLAND FISH

There were on hand 5,067,000 lb. of inland fish frozen fresh and 2,000 lb. frozen smoked. There were also 153,000 lb. of inland fish frozen during February.
